Licensed Daycare or Preschool Providers

Childcare center means a public or nonprofit facility that provides educational, social, health and nutritional services to children through age 14 (or as prescribed by State law). The facility must be approved or licensed by the State or other appropriate authority as a child day care center or childcare center.

Apply for Eligibility

To apply to receive surplus property simply open, print, and fill-out the [Nonprofit Organization Eligibility Application](#).

Additional Application Requirements:

Nonprofit Organizations: include a copy of your tax-exempt status letter from the IRS.

Include a copy of your state certification, approval or license

Include a description of your program including facility, staffing, and number of children served.
