

ANA/CNA v.D Realignment



When is a Notification of Planned Action needed?

Scenario	NoPA Needed?	Explanation
The individual's authorized hours are reduced by the new assessment.	Yes	An individual <u>must</u> receive a NoPA whenever a developmental disability service is reduced.
The new assessment has resulted in fewer hours than the last assessment, but the same or greater hours as were authorized in the ISP.	No	There is no reduction in the amount of hours that the individual had authorized.
An exception is requested due to the results of the ANA v.D assessment <u>and</u> the exception is approved equal to or greater than the number of hours authorized in last years' ISP and it is received a minimum of 10 days prior to the ISP end date.	No	There is no reduction in the amount of hours that the individual was authorized.
A second assessment is completed by ReBAR and the hours are equal to or greater than the previous year.	No	There is no reduction in the amount of hours that the individual was authorized.
An exception is requested following a reduction of hours based on a new assessment, and the exception is denied or a response is not received from ODDS a minimum of 10 days prior to the end date of the ISP.	Yes	An individual <u>must</u> receive a NoPA whenever a developmental disability service authorization is reduced.
