Subject: Providence ElderPlace (PACE)

During Phase I of the Subcommittee's hearings on the budget for Seniors and People with Disabilities, committee members asked several questions about Providence ElderPlace.

Providence ElderPlace is a "Program of All Inclusive Care for the Elderly" (PACE).

Two main questions were posed. The first was the numbers and types of settings in which PACE clients live. This is reflected on page 1 of the attachment.

The second was around outcome data and program effectiveness. Page 2 compares medical outcome data across difference service approaches.
