

Oregon Together! Criteria

The following criteria must be met prior to a community coalition being recognized as an official Oregon Together! Community

1. Has the coalition recruited a group of community "Key Leaders?"
2. Have the "Key Leaders" been through a Key Leader Orientation Training?
3. Do the "Key Leaders" meet on a regular basis?
4. Does the coalition have an official "Community Board" formed?
5. Are the "Community Board" members active and meeting on a regular basis (i.e., monthly, bi-monthly)?
6. Have the "Community Board" members received formal training in the risk/protective factor framework?
7. Does the community have an updated (within the past 2 years) risk/resource assessment?
8. Has the coalition been trained in science-based "Best Practices" or "Promising Approaches" to reduce risk factors and increase protective factors?
9. Has the coalition developed an "Action Plan" of strategies and activities that address their prioritized risk/protective factors?
