Agenda Item	Technical Update (OMAP/OIS)
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Transaction Form Update - Handout

Natalie Rodgers discussed each Transaction Form update. All 800 series are in B2B. The 834 Transaction is in production. Plans receive the weekly 834 and they will receive the monthly 834 Transaction at the end of the month. Pam and Natalie will meet with Patricia on April 4th to discuss issues surrounding dual systems (bulletin board and HIPAA mailboxes). December 31, 2005 is the DHS cut-off date for dual systems. We will be intensifying efforts to get everyone switched over before the end of the year cutoff. Comment period for the 820 weekly and monthly test ended on March 11th. There was only one comment regarding the fixed length of the PERC code. Marcia Mee indicated Care Oregon had a comment, but neither the HIPAA Project Office nor the TEDS unit received the comment. Marcia will go back and resubmit comments. Natalie will get with her and get comments to right person. The HIPAA Project office provided a demonstration of the 270/271 real time process for the EDI Test Team last week. OCHIN has been identified as the pilot tester for the 270/271 Transaction. Testing should begin the week of March 21st. Results will be shared with the group over the course of April. Natalie reported they are working on the 276/277- batch mode and are finished with system testing and moving ahead. DHS is looking for a FFS tester. Once IHN is done with NCPDP testing, everyone will be done.

Web Updates

The State of Oregon website site has been changed; this includes the DHS HIPAA site. HIPAA Taskforce handouts are on site as well. Individuals may sign up for e-subscribe, a free service that will send DHS updates automatically. Users should select their areas of interest. The 834 and 820 companion guides are posted and the companion guide review committee will meet to go over the 200 series companion guides starting next week. Lillian stated she couldn't get to the web site and Nancy said she would work with Lillian to help her log on.

270/271 Real Time Process

Natalie walked the group through the handout, which showed the Real time process step-by-step. People on the teleconferencing will receive the handout via fax or email. There was a question about the TA1 or 997. Natalie is going to check this and get back to group. Each plan will populate their own screens that will connect to DHS. It will be up to each plan on how they want to develop this. Discussion about password and the security risk if you pass out password to others. The cutover is still December 31, 2005 for 270/271. Cut off dates are out on website. Pilot test results for the 270/271 with OCHIN will be published. Pat Van Dyke asked the group if they were picking up the 997 or TA1s and using them in their system. Plans should be prepared to share that information at the next meeting.

Handout provided. There is also information about this on the website. There was discussion of legislative bills regarding taxpayers having bank accounts to receive EFT. Patricia will update any news on either bill.
