

The purpose of the HIPAA Transition Plan and Progress Report is to demonstrate the Oregon Department of Human Services (DHS) progress towards achieving HIPAA compliance for the 837 Claim and 835 Remittance Advice transactions. This report illustrates the phases that DHS Trading Partners must complete in order to obtain Production status.

<b>REGISTRATION PHASE: Readiness Statistics Definitions</b>	
Total Active DHS Providers	The total count of Medicaid healthcare providers who have submitted a claim for medical services to the Office of Medical Assistance Programs (OMAP) in the past year.
Paper Claims Providers	The count of providers who have submitted a paper claim medical service. This is a derived number and reflects the difference between Total Active and Electronic Claims Providers. Percentage is calculated as a proportion of Total Active DHS Providers.
Electronic Claims Providers	The count of providers who have submitted an electronic medical service claim. Percentage is calculated as a proportion of Total Active DHS Providers.
Unregistered Providers	The count of Electronic Claims Providers who HAVE NOT submitted an Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Packet to DHS. Percentage is calculated as a proportion of Electronic Claims Providers.
Registered Providers (TP)	The count of Electronic Claims Providers who HAVE submitted an EDI Packet to DHS and have a complete Trading Partner Agreement (TPA) on file. Percentage is calculated as a proportion of Electronic Claims Providers. Registered providers may indicate more than one HIPAA transaction on their TPA. Registered providers are considered active members of the DHS Trading Partner (TP) community and this population is used to determine DHS progress toward achieving HIPAA compliance.
837P FFS	The count of Registered Providers who have indicated they will submit HIPAA 837P Fee-for-Service (FFS) transactions to OMAP. This count serves as the denominator to 837P FFS Third Party Test (TPT), Business-to-Business (B2B), and Production phase statistics.
837I FFS	The count of Registered Providers who have indicated they will submit HIPAA 837I FFS transactions to OMAP. This count serves as the denominator to 837I FFS TPT, B2B, and Production phase statistics.
837D FFS	The count of Registered Providers who have indicated they will submit HIPAA 837D FFS transactions to OMAP. This count serves as the denominator to 837D FFS TPT, B2B, and Production phase statistics.
837P ENC	The count of Registered Providers who have indicated they will submit HIPAA 837P Encounter (ENC) transactions to OMAP. This count serves as the denominator to 837P ENC TPT, B2B, and Production phase statistics.
837I ENC	The count of Registered Providers who have indicated they will submit HIPAA 837I ENC transactions to OMAP. This count serves as the denominator to 837I ENC TPT, B2B, and Production phase statistics.
837D ENC	The count of Registered Providers who have indicated they will submit HIPAA 837D ENC transactions to OMAP. This count serves as the denominator to 837D ENC TPT, B2B, and Production phase statistics.
