Comments were sent to Rick Howard who made a Business Decision - Based on responses from PHPs and further considerations, OMAP will not implement this proposal. 8/23/04: The official Business Decision was posted to the Web.

Crosswalk Completed:

DHS Response: JAD Sessions were held w/PHPs in July and August 2003 to crosswalk HIPAA Adjustment Reason Codes (HARC) to Disposition and Delete Reason Codes. PHPs shall review quarterly HARC updates as they occur to add or deactivate codes listed on the DHS HARC/Disposition Code Crosswalk via Encounter Data Work Group meetings. While PHPs have input into the disposition of HARCs, OMAP has final authority and discretion.

*09/03/04: In May 2004 a pilot test was successfully run using a file from NW Dental. The file contained the Plan Tracking Number but DHS was not ready to process it. The Plan Tracking Number work was completed and the same NW Dental pilot file was run again. This test was also successful. Results were placed in NW Dental's mailbox.
 HPO considers this transaction ready for B2B testing. We are ahead of the scheduled November production implementation time frame.

*10/11/04: No update since last report shown below. DHS HPO has not received any feedback from NW Dental. DHS programming has been implemented into production ahead of the scheduled November time frame. Last Report Dated 09/03/04.

*11/05/04: It was determined at the October Task Force meeting that a successful pilot test of adjustments and deletes is needed before DHS can consider this transaction fully operational in production. DHS is currently engaged in a pilot test with NW Dental and looks for results of that test to be made available to NW Dental by the end of November.

*12/01/04: It was determined at the October Task Force meeting that a successful pilot test of adjustments and deletes is needed before DHS can consider this transaction fully operational in production. DHS is currently engaged in a pilot test with NW Dental. Results were expected by the end of November, but trading partner agreement updates and issues with the pilot file data extended the time frame. New file received on 11/30 and results are expected by mid-December.
