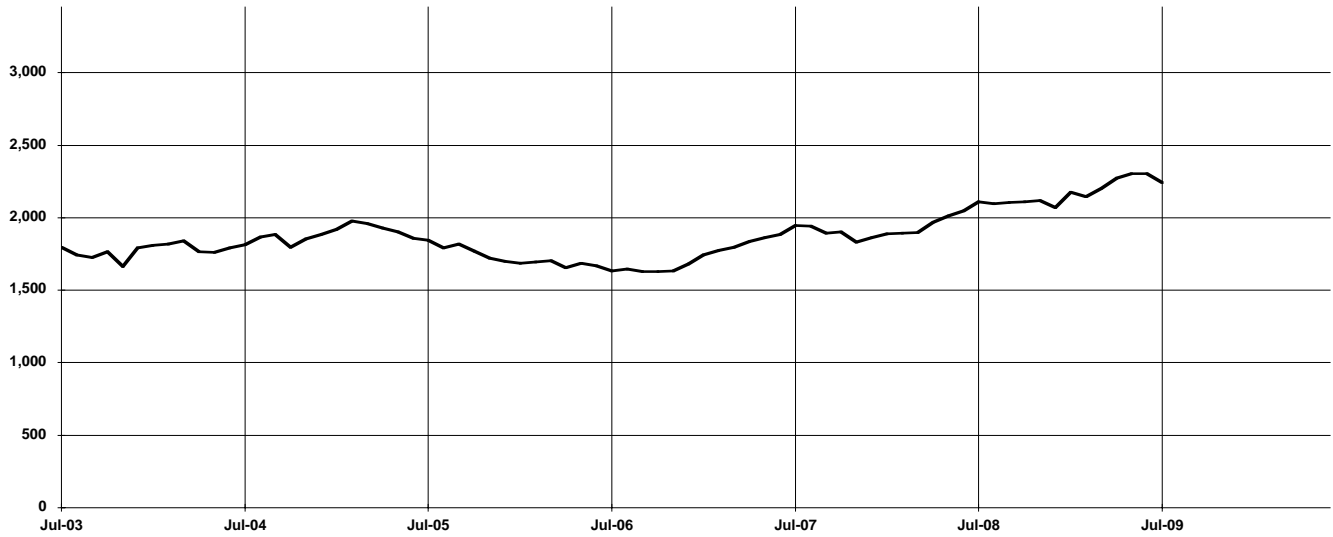

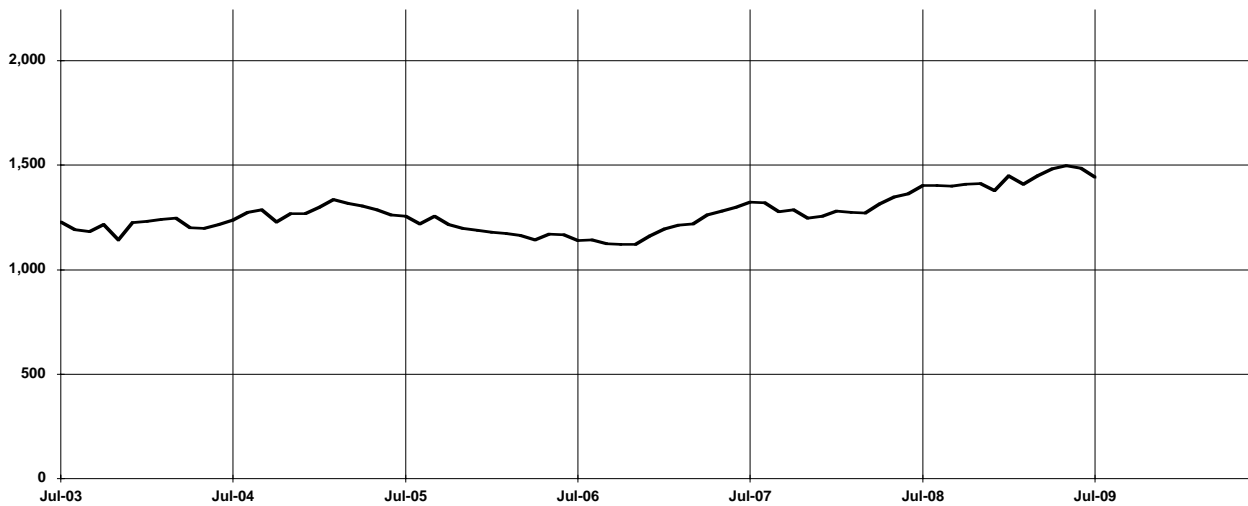

District 6 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) One- and Two-Parent Program Person Count



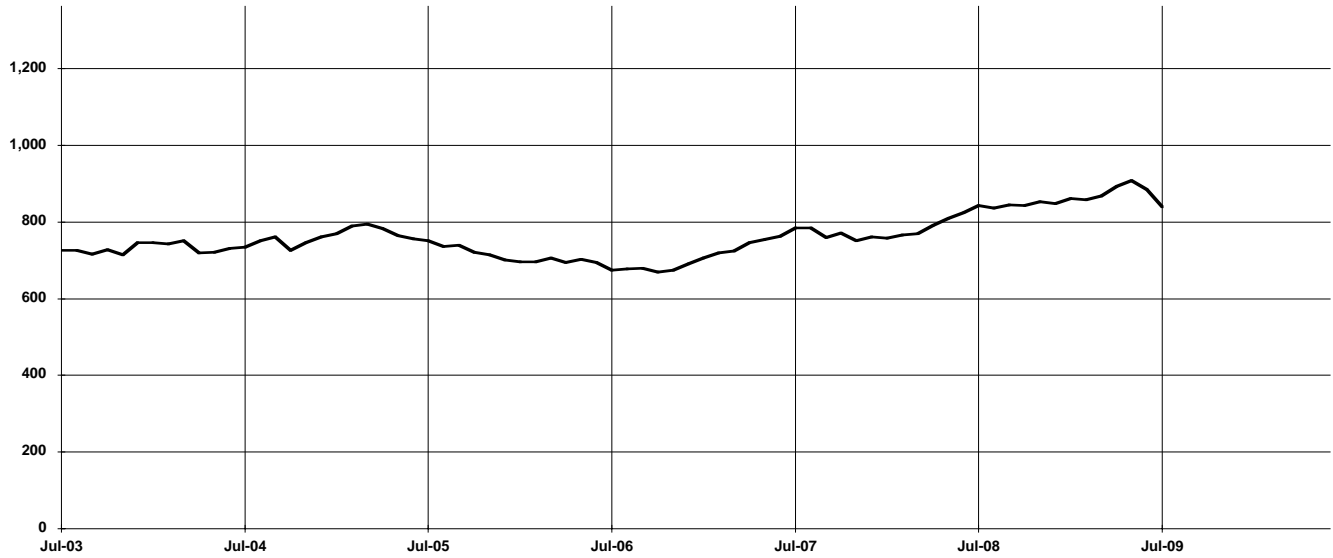

District 6 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) One- and Two-Parent Program Child Count



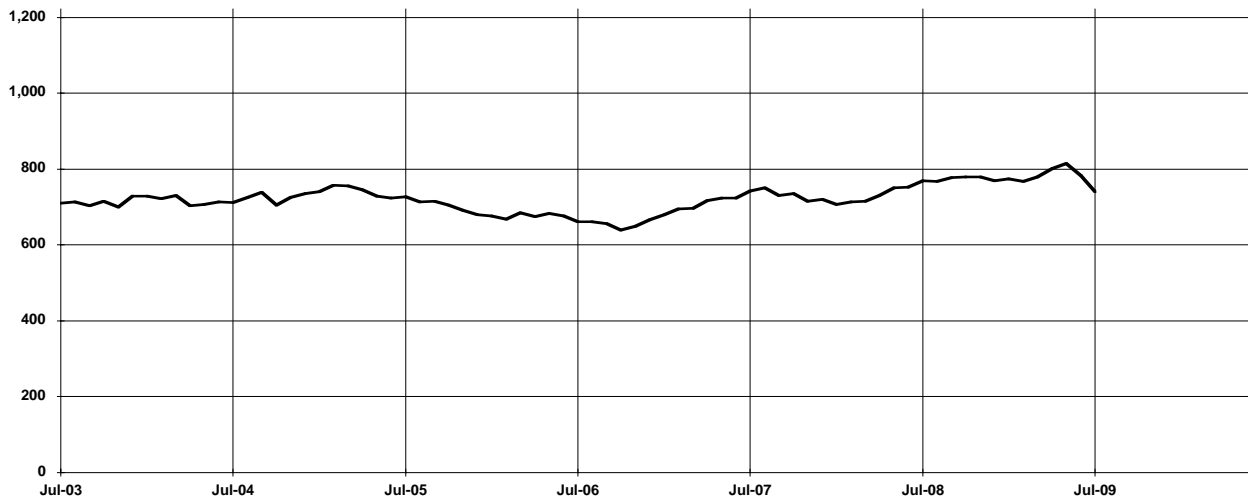

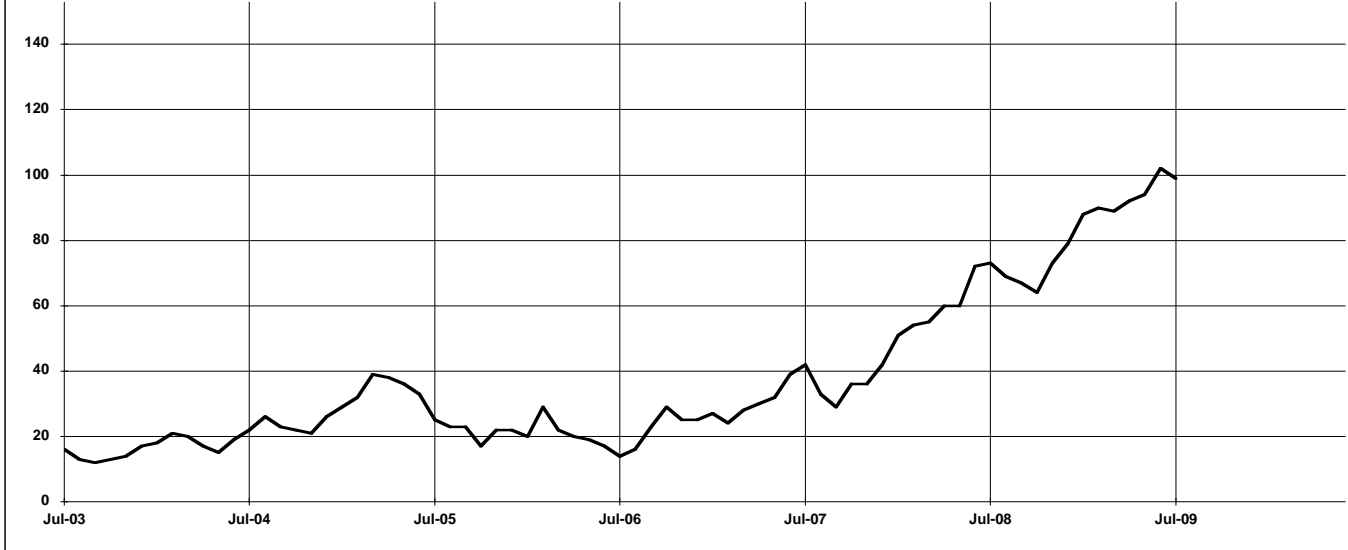

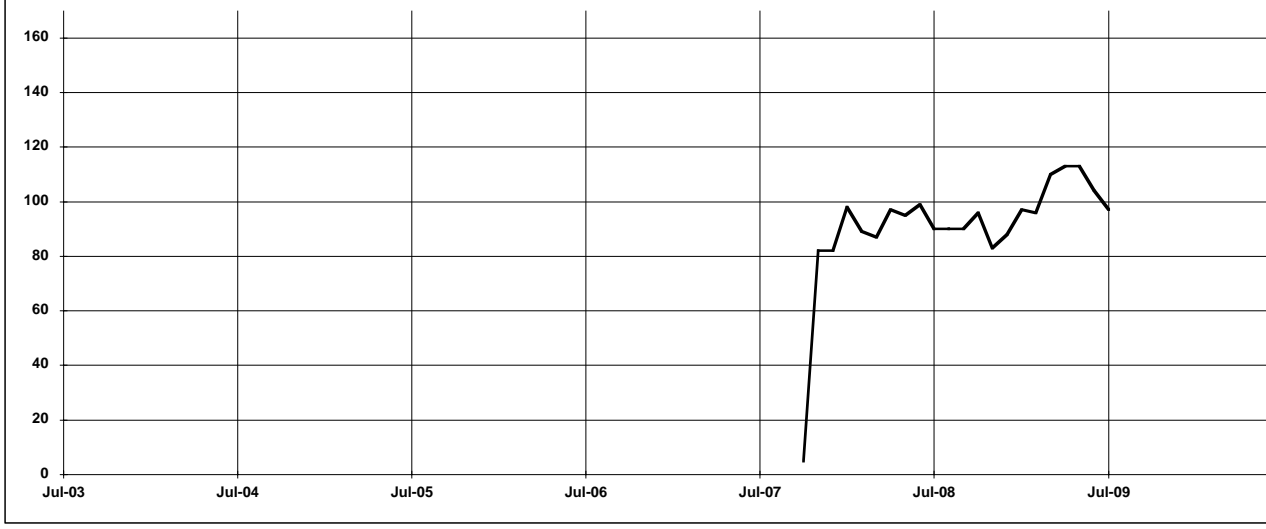

District 6 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Two-parent Program Case Count (TANF-UN)



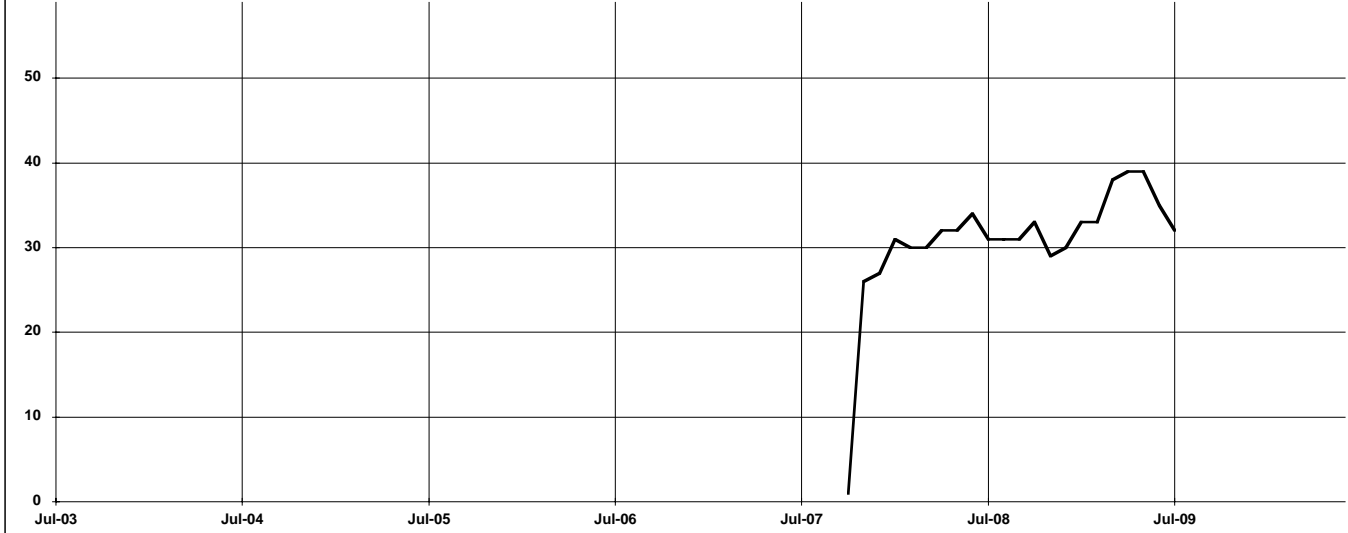

District 6 State Family Pre-SSI/SSDI Program Person Count



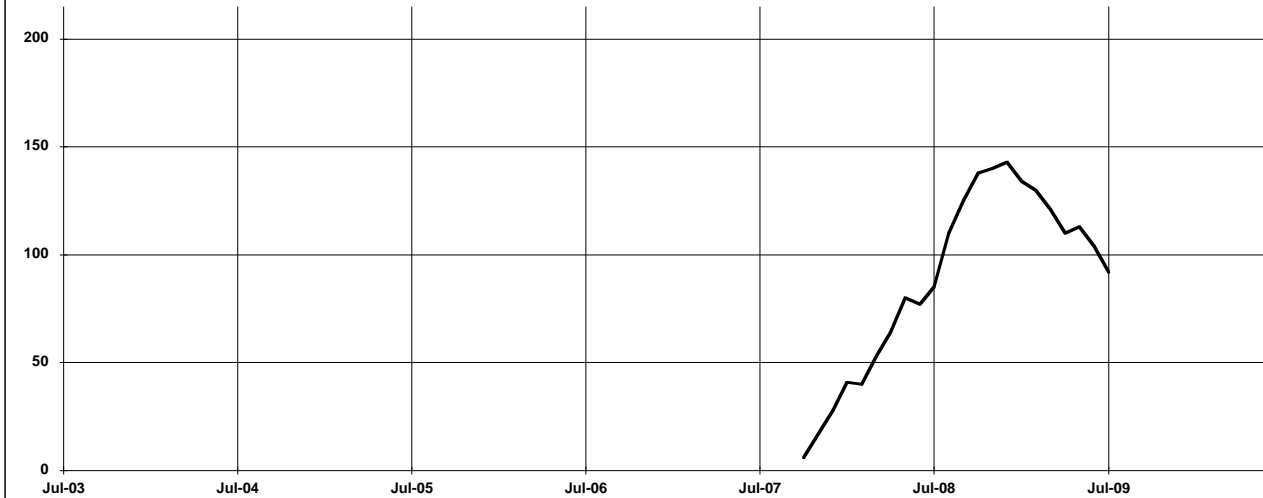

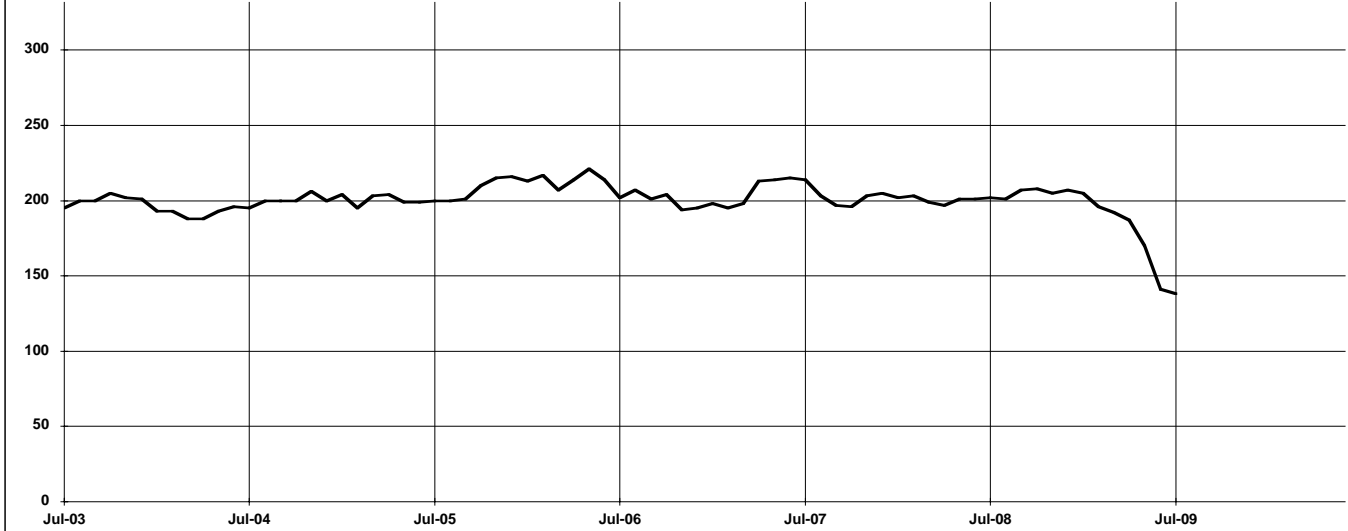
District 6 Post-TANF Cases

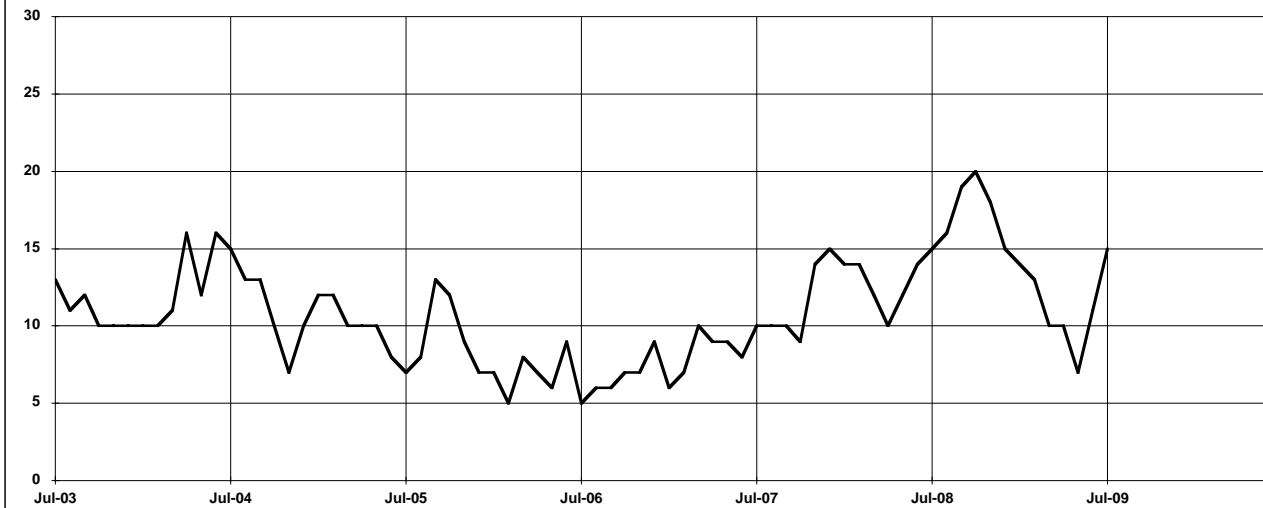
District 6 Basic/UN Cases with No Adult in the Grant

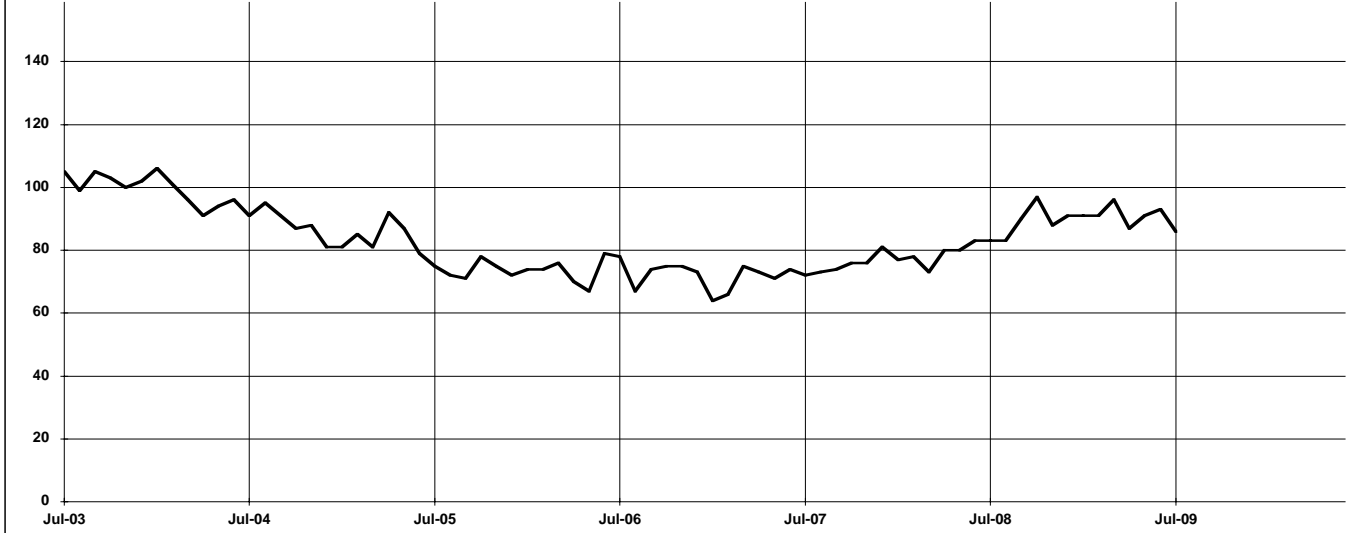

District 6 Minor Parent Cases where the Younger Parent is 17 or Under



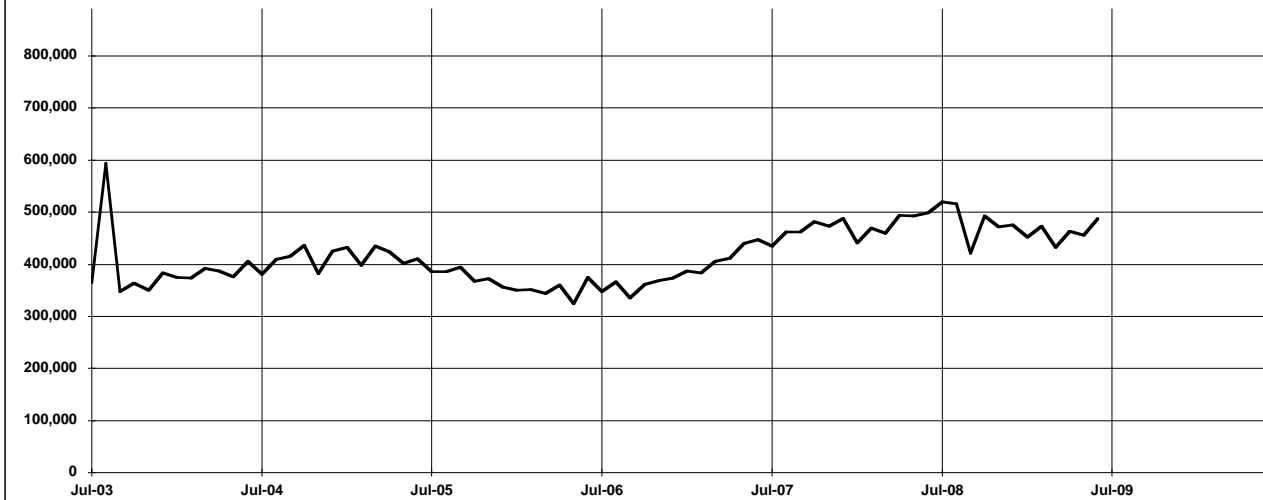

District 6 Young Parent Cases where the Younger Parent is 18 or 19



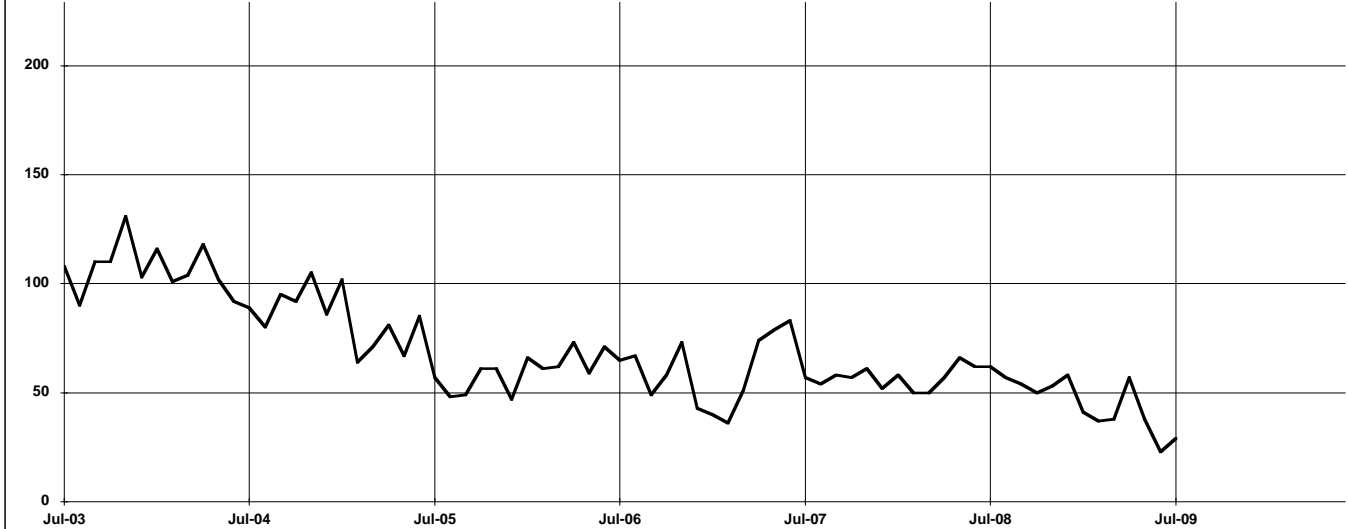

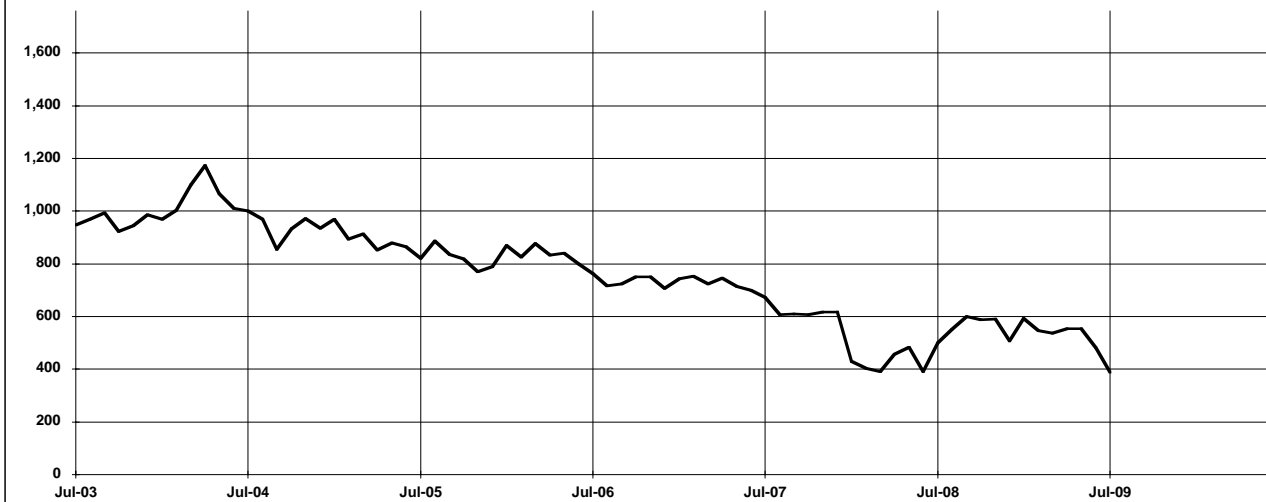
District 6 Pre-TANF Program Participants

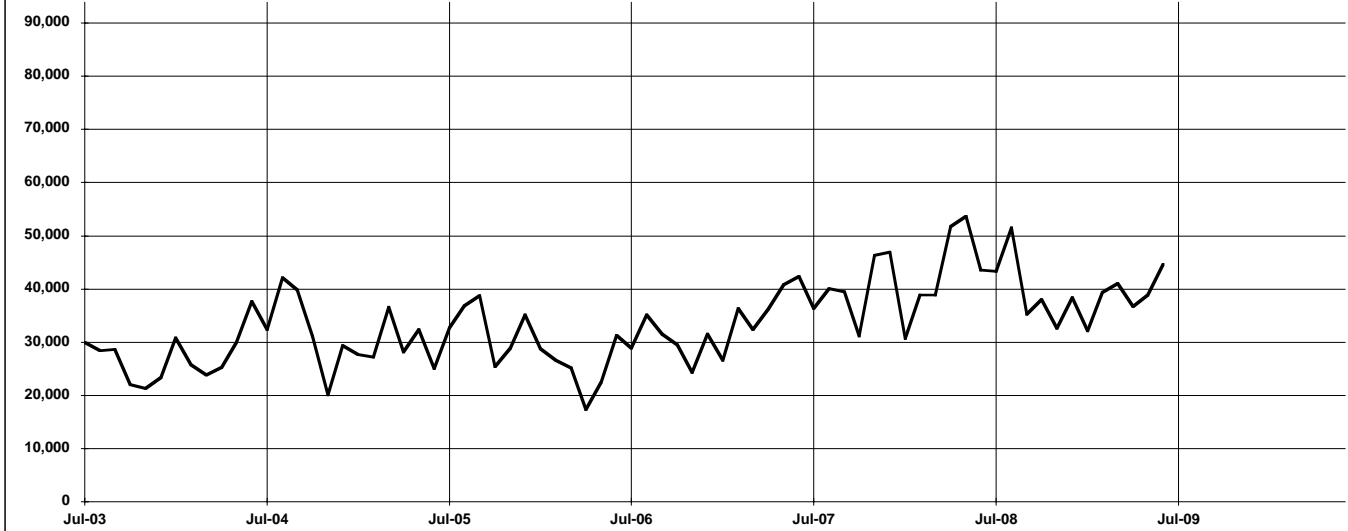
District 6 Total JOBS Participants

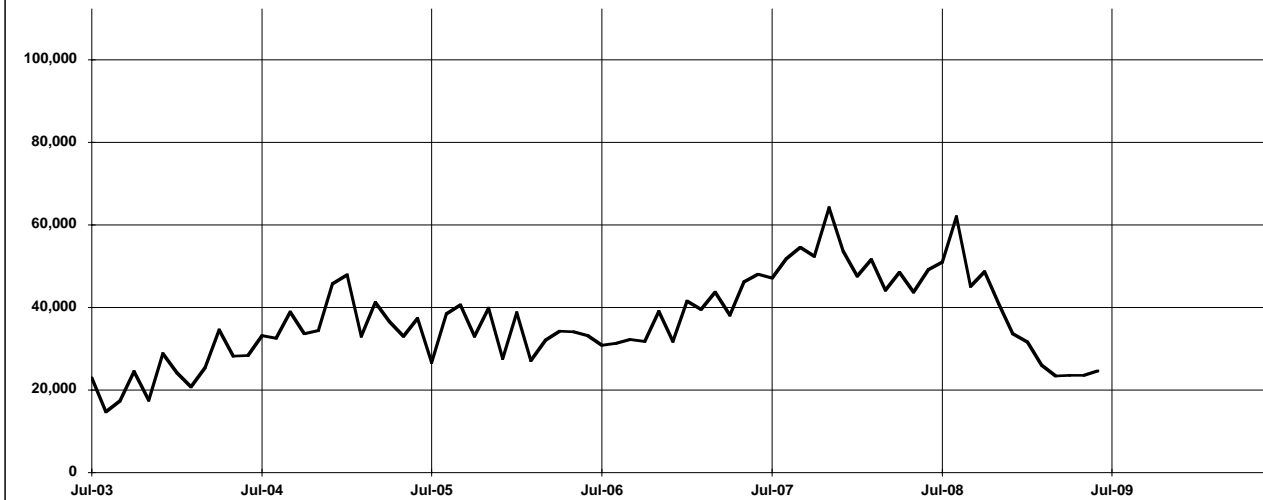

District 6 JOBS Non-contracted Day Care Expenditures



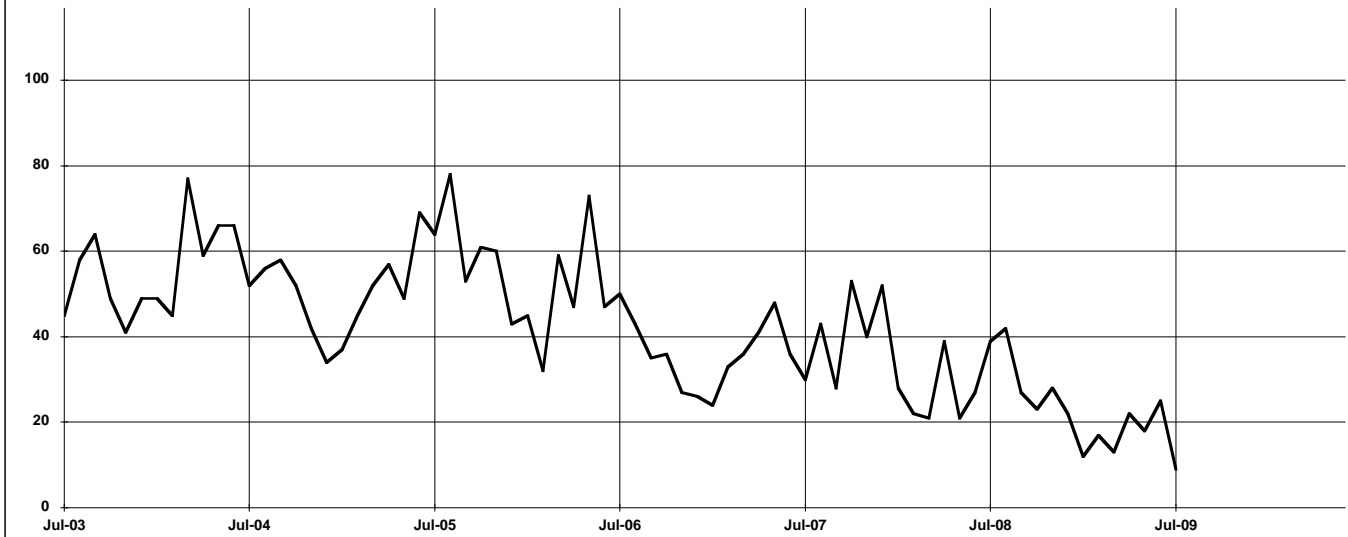

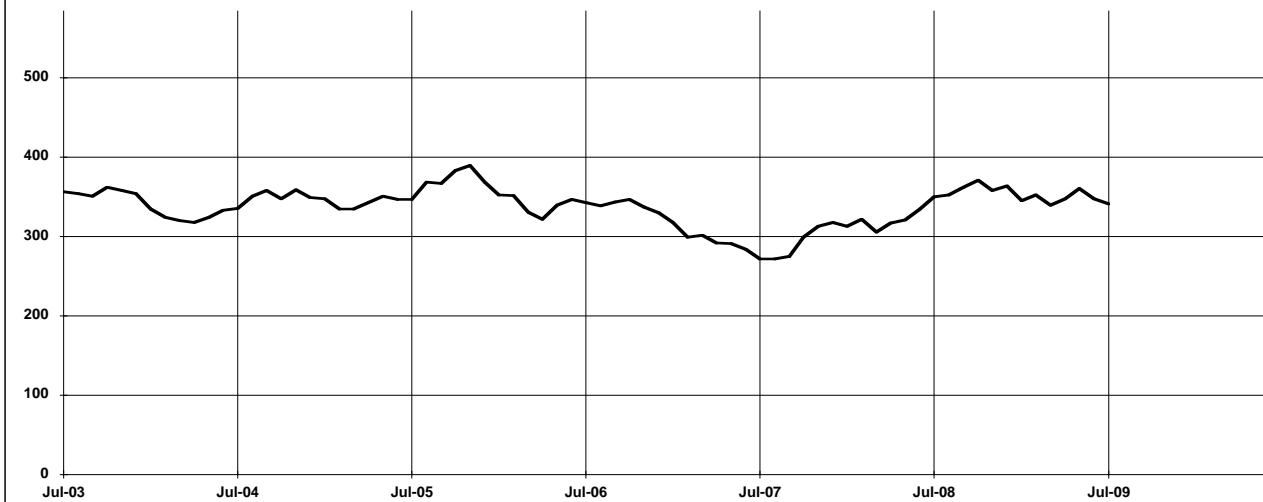

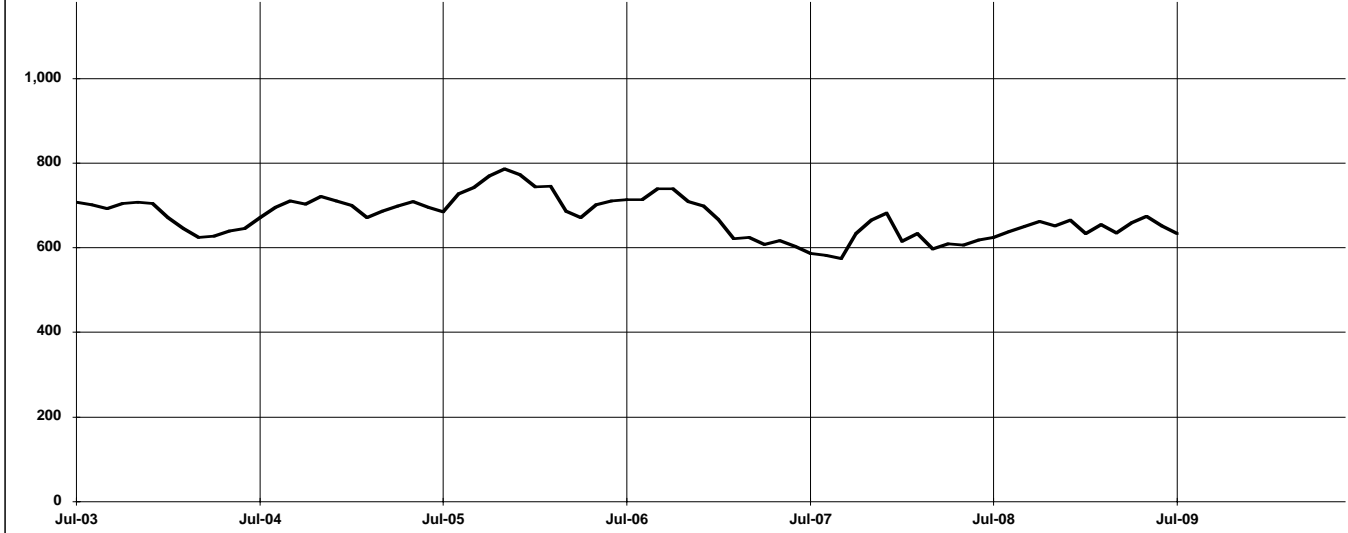
District 6 Total Employment-Related Daycare (ERDC) Cases

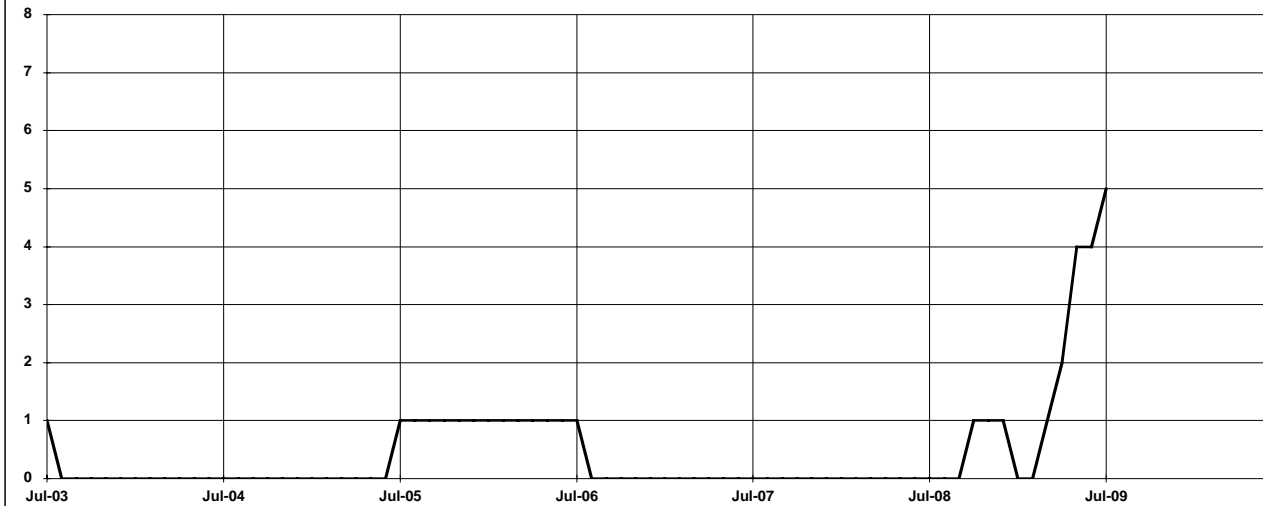
District 6 Total Employment-Related Daycare (ERDC) Children in Care

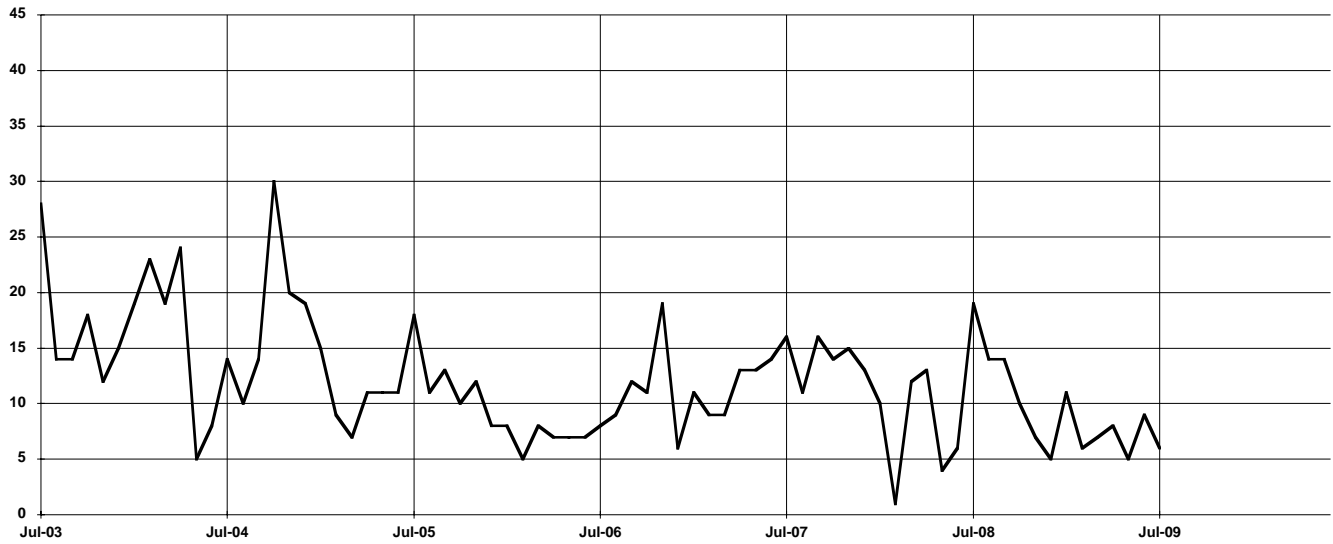
District 6 JOBS Plus Daycare Cases (Included in Total)

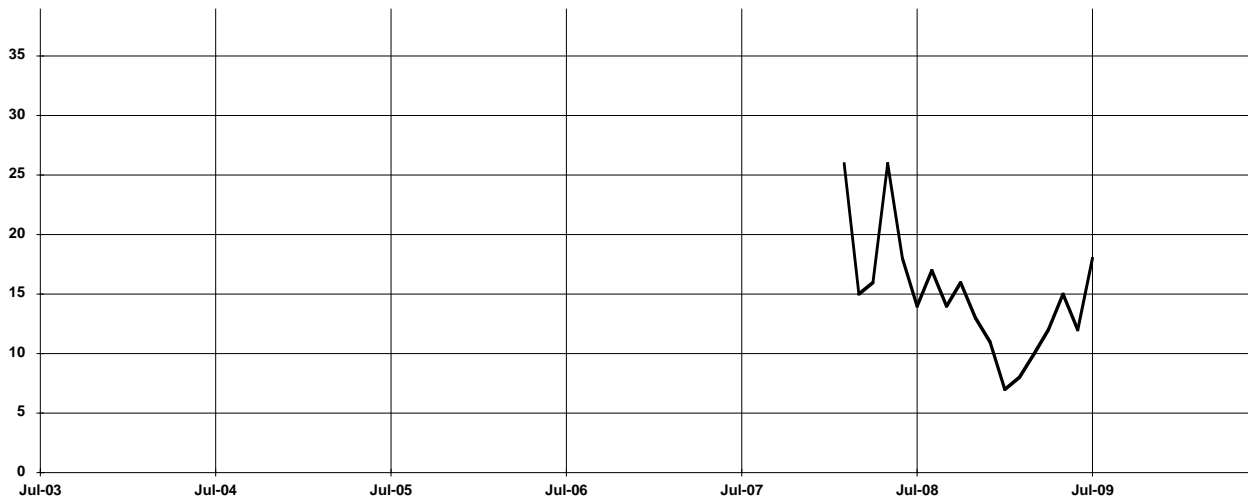
District 6 Temporary Assistance for Domestic Violence Survivors Cases with Payment

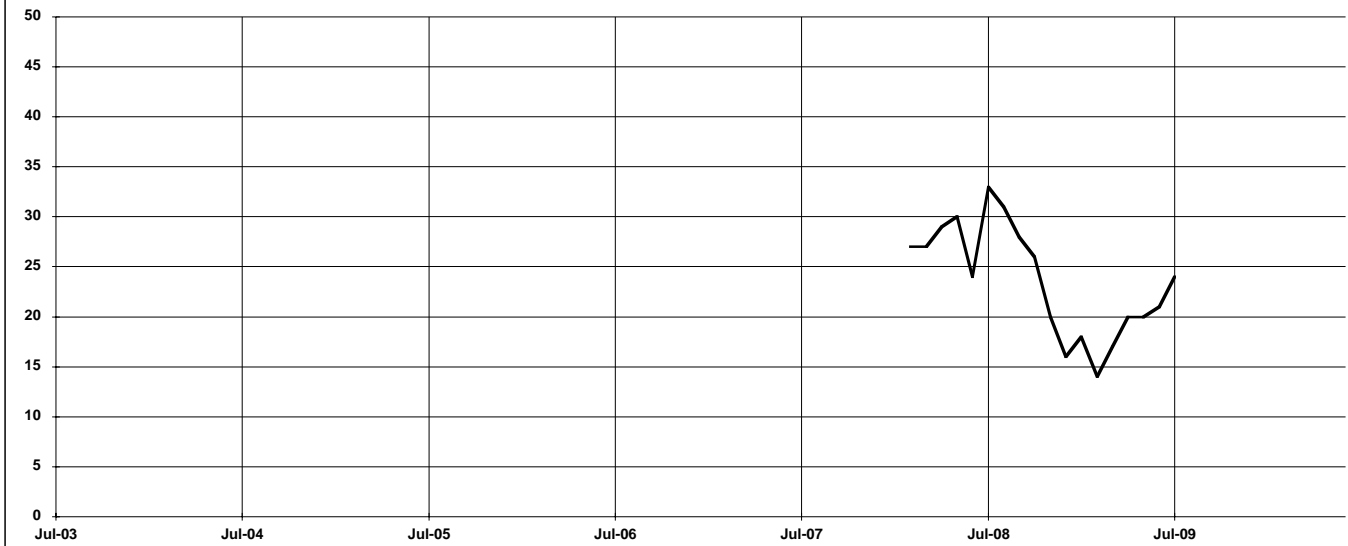

District 6 Temporary Assistance for Domestic Violence Survivors Cases without Payment



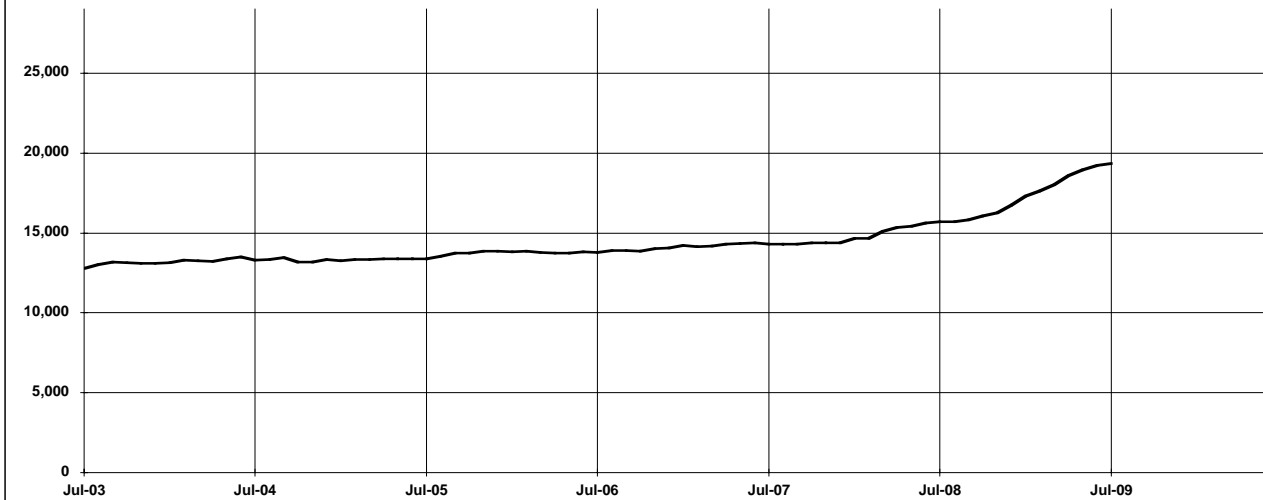

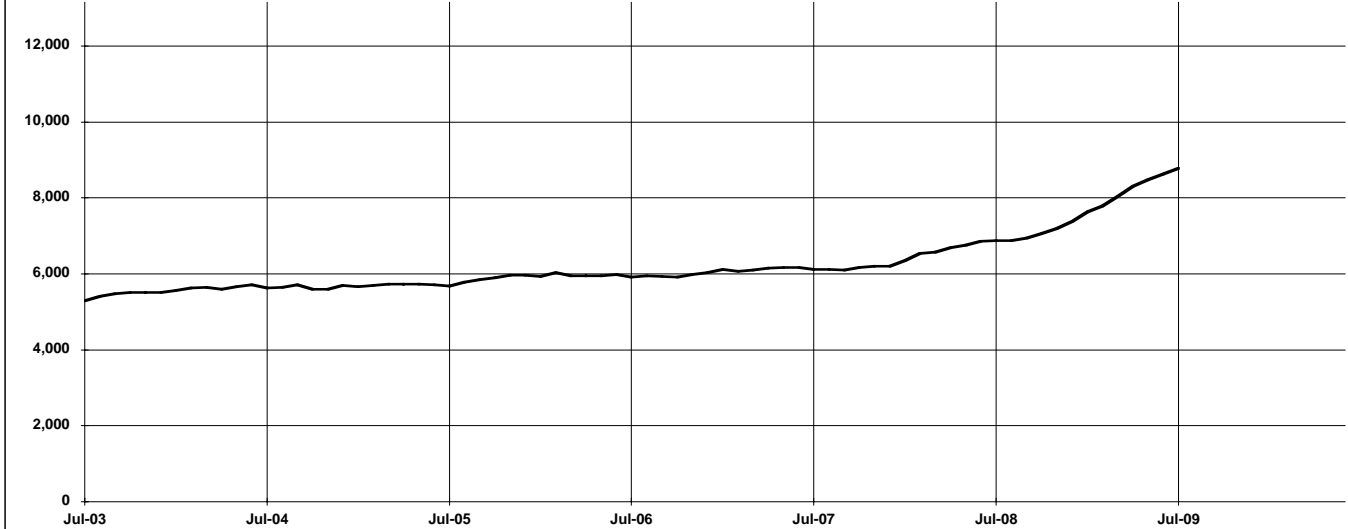
District 6 Children, Adults and Families (CAF) Total Food Stamp Persons

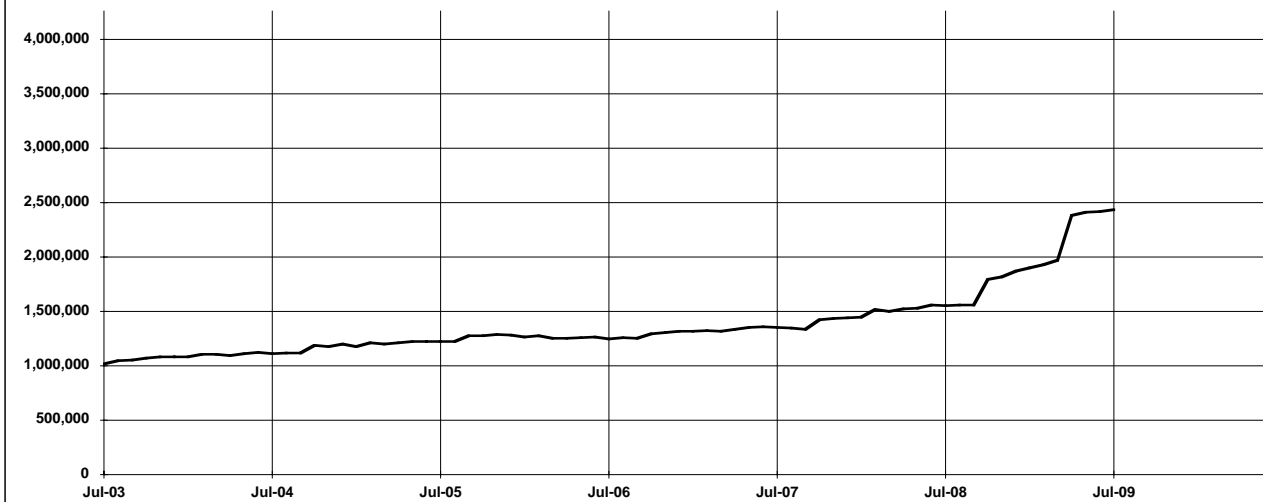
District 6 CAF Total Food Stamp Households

"A" denotes the top chart on the page indicated, "B" is the bottom chart.

- 5B, 6A** The State Family Pre-SSI/SSDI program began October 1, 2007. It provides assistance to those families where one person is applying for SSI or SSDI.
- 6B** The Post-TANF Program started October 1, 2007.
- 7 A** Basic cases with no adult in the grant include the following reasons: no parent household, SSI parent, support sanction, ineligible alien head of household, adults disqualified for either JOBS, mental health, or program violation, and some for which the reason is unknown.
- 9 A** The Pre-TANF Program started July 1997.
- 9 B** The manner of counting participants in the JOBS program changed with July 1997 data. We are now counting all participants instead of only those in federally approved activities. As of January 2008 the data in this report counts the unduplicated number of participants.
- 11 A** In September 2006, the method of reporting placements changed. All placements recorded on this chart are TANF only now. Prior to September 2006, the Food Stamp placements were included with the TANF placements. As of July 1, 2007, the placement criteria changed.
- 11B, 12A** The method of counting day care caseloads/children changed with February 1995 data. In the past, a day care case was counted only if it received a payment. Provider billings often do not directly follow daycare usage, resulting in understated caseloads and child counts. All active cases are now counted, resulting in increased child and case counts, and corresponding decreases in the cost per case and cost per child in all daycare programs.
As of October 1, 2007, the Student Block Grant program is no longer included in the Day Care totals. The program was transferred to the Oregon Student Assistance Commission.
As of September 2008 the data source for this report was updated to fully include teens in the count.
- 12 B** As of July 1997, JOBS Plus Daycare became a part of Employment Related Day Care.
- 13A, 13B, 14A** There is currently no funding for non-domestic violence Emergency Assistance. TA-DVS (Domestic Violence EA) is still funded. As of February 2008, we began reporting total TA-DVS cases, whether or not they received a payment in the month.
- 14B, 15A, 15B** All food stamp information in this chart book is for Children, Adults and Families only; no information for Seniors and People with Disabilities is included. For statewide food stamp information, see the "State of Oregon Department of Human Services Public Assistance Data Charts Statewide Data" book. District 1 experienced an increase in food stamp cases in December 2007 due to the Disaster Food Stamp Program.
- NOTE:** All expenditures in this book represent payments made during the data month, but may not be for services provided in the data month. Day care payments, especially, may be for services received one or two months prior to the data month shown. Negative expenditure amounts are caused by refunding from prior months' expenditures or by expenditure transfers to optimize certain types of funds.
