<p><b>ORS 418.005 (CWAC)</b>          (b) Advisory committee membership shall include representatives of other state agencies concerned with services, representatives of professional, civic or other public or private organizations, private citizens interested in service programs, and recipients of assistance or service or their representatives.</p>	<p><b>Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act</b>          The State task force shall include—          (A) individuals representing the law enforcement community;          (B) judges and attorneys involved in both civil and criminal court proceedings related to child abuse and neglect (including individuals involved with the defense as well as the prosecution of such cases);          (C) child advocates, including both attorneys for children and, where such programs are in operation, court appointed special advocates;          (D) health and mental health professionals;          (E) individuals representing child protective service agencies;          (F) individuals experienced in working with children with disabilities;          (G) parents; and          (H) representatives of parents' groups.</p>
