

## 2008 Mental Health: Adult Licensed Residential Settings (Cases, Allegations and Substantiated Abuse)

Clients in a residential setting include adults living in mental health treatment facilities and treatment homes, as well as foster homes. Investigators conducted 105 abuse investigations of 177 allegations of abuse for 120 clients. 50 of the 120 clients were found to have been abused or neglected. 41 paid caregivers and agencies were found responsible for the abuse.

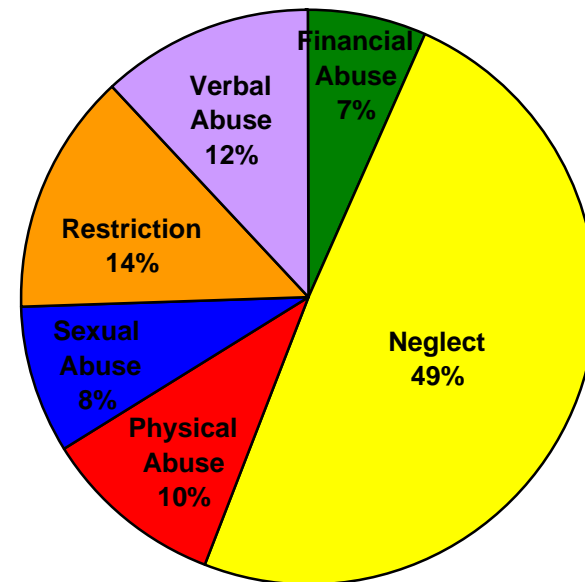
