
Oregon Health Plan (OHP) adds a new benefit package



OHP with Limited Drug benefit package

You receive the OHP with Limited Drug benefit package if you are eligible for Medicare Part D. The new package is identified with a D in Field 9b of your OMAP Medical Care ID.

The new quick reference chart (attached) shows which services are available to clients with various OHP benefit packages. It replaces the chart on Page 17 of the current client handbook.

OHP with Limited Drug coverage

The OHP with Limited Drug benefit package covers some drugs that are not covered by Medicare Part D. These drugs are only covered if the prescription is for a covered condition and complies with all current Oregon Administrative Rules and procedures.

Note: If you opted out of Medicare Part D, OHP cannot pay for your drugs that Medicare Part D would cover. You will have to pay for them yourself.

Show your ID cards

It is very important that you show your pharmacist both your Medicare Part D drug plan card as well as your OMAP Medical Care ID. This will help your drugstore bill the correct program.

OHP with Limited Drug copayments

You may have to make a copayment for the outpatient services and OHP prescription drugs you receive. Copayments are the same as those listed on Page 15 of the current client handbook.

OHP does **not** pay Medicare premiums or copayments for Medicare Part D drug plans or services.
