**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY
REPORT ON OREGON HEALTH PLAN (OHP)
UTILIZATION AND ENROLLMENT FOR
ADDICTION TREATMENT SERVICES:
APRIL 1, 2006 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2007**

Introduction

The purpose of this document is to provide DHS, managed care plans, and stakeholders with information about alcohol and drug treatment services OHP members receive through managed care and fee-for-service delivery systems.

This report covers April 1, 2006 through March 31, 2007. The data was pulled from cleansed paid claims available in the Decision Support/ Surveillance and Utilization Review System (DSSURS) as of October 3, 2007.

Population

- Enrollment information reflects Medicaid eligible individuals enrolled in managed care plans and those who receive care through fee-for-service delivery systems.
- Over a three-month period an individual may be in one or more eligibility types or FCHPs. An individual may be counted more than once due to changes in enrollment.
- Utilization data reflects Medicaid eligible individuals use of services treating chemical dependency disorders. Data reflects individuals serviced through managed care plans and fee-for-service delivery systems.

Take Home Points

- Chemical dependency service utilization among all enrollees remains very low (see Table 2), ranging from a high of 2.7% for Family Care to a low of 0.2% for Tuality.
- Service utilization among adults (age 18+) is mostly in the 3% range, while utilization among adolescents (age 12-17) is generally in the 1% range (see Table 3).
- According to 2006 data from the National Survey on Drug Use and Health 10% of Oregon's general population is in need of drug and/or alcohol treatment. This suggests that the current service utilization among OHP members is very low.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

CONTINUED

- Among adolescents, services are most commonly for abuse and/or dependence related to cannabis (more than half) and alcohol (close to a third).
- Among adults, services are most commonly for abuse and/or dependence related to alcohol, amphetamines, and opioids. The availability of synthetic opioid replacement treatment programs in the coverage area increases the prevalence of opioid abuse/dependence in the various plans' treatment populations.
- Among adults and adolescents the most common services are assessments, group therapy, and individual therapy. Other forms of service vary greatly among plans, indicating either some specialization among the plans or their service population.

Limitations

- This report does not include tests of the statistical significance of apparent differences between providers or across time lines.
- The report is a "snap-shot" in time for the specific report being created.
- According to administrative rule Managed Care Organizations may submit encounters to DMAP 180 days after receipt of claims from service providers. Fee-for Service encounters may be submitted to DMAP for payment up to 1 year after service was provided.

Report Schedule

- This is the initial report and from now on will be created on a quarterly basis.
- The purpose of this document is to provide DHS divisions, managed care plans and stakeholders with information about alcohol and drug treatment services OHP individuals receive through managed care and fee-for-service delivery systems.

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The format and contents are constructed as follows:

- Tables are used to summarize quarterly data at the Prepaid Health Plan (PHP) level. Some tables include Fee for Service (FFS) and All Eligibles.



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ENROLLMENT DATA

- ❖ Enrolled: Eligible for OHP and enrolled in an FCHP or CDO
- ❖ Eligibles: Total of Enrolled and FFS
- ❖ Fee-For-Service (FFS): Eligible for OHP and NOT enrolled with an FCHP/CDO (Open Card)







Glossaries



CD UTILIZATION REPORT GLOSSARY

ADDICTIONS AND MENTAL HEALTH DIVISION (AMH):

A division of the Department of Human Services responsible for the administration of addiction and mental health services for the State of Oregon.

ELIGIBLE:

An individual eligible for services under the Oregon Health Plan (OHP). The individual may or may not be enrolled into an FCHP or CDO. Includes enrolled and fee-for-service.

ENCOUNTER:

An outpatient contact or Covered Services provided to an OHP Member.

ENROLLED (ENROLLEE):

Eligible for the Oregon Health Plan (OHP) and enrolled in an FCHP or CDO.

FEE-FOR-SERVICE (FFS):

Individuals who are eligible for the OHP, but are not enrolled with a PHP. This is also known as fee-for-service (FFS) or an “open card”.

OREGON HEALTH PLAN (OHP):

Oregon's health care reform effort consisting of a Medicaid Demonstration Project, State Children's Health Insurance Program, an individual insurance program for persons excluded from health insurance coverage due to pre-existing health conditions, and a group insurance program for small businesses. One objective of this reform effort includes universal coverage for Oregonians. In the context of this report, OHP refers to individuals on the PHP/FFS Utilization Report Glossary.

PERCENT ENROLLEES SERVED:

This is a general measure of access, but more related to utilization of services. It is a percentage calculated by summing the unique enrollees seen during a given time period and dividing that number by the total enrollees for that time period. For example, if there is 10,000 enrollees statewide in a given month and during that same month 500 of those enrollees receive services, the percent of enrollees served is 5%.

UNIQUE SERVED:

Unduplicated number of individuals receiving alcohol and drug treatment services.

UNIQUE ENCOUNTERS:

Unduplicated services received by an individual(s) within a specific time period. One individual may have had several services provided – each service would be part of the calculations.
