

Have you registered for replacement MMIS training?

Learn about what will change

Did you know that the replacement MMIS will change the way you do business with DHS?

- The 8 1/2" x 11" DMAP Medical Care Identification will be replaced with a wallet-sized card;
- Web-based verification services will change from AIS Plus to the Provider Web Portal;
- Telephone-based verification services will change from AIS to Automated Voice Response (AVR).

These are just a few of the changes that will take place. All providers who bill through the MMIS need to learn how things will change in September 2008.

Get the tools you need

When you register and attend one of the statewide trainings, you will get the most current information about the replacement MMIS, including:

- Updated contacts - Fax/telephone numbers and mailing addresses.
- Copies of the new forms that will be used in the replacement MMIS for prior authorizations, fax cover sheets, and more.
- Step-by-step instructions on how to bill DHS using the Provider Web Portal (including Web-based Medicare-Medicaid crossover claims, where applicable).
- Quick references for how to verify client eligibility in the replacement MMIS.
- Information about the new remittance advice format and Explanation of Benefit (EOB) codes.
