Subject: Medicaid payment/enrollment system changes



As you know, DHS is replacing the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS). There will be several changes in the way DHS communicates with you. If you haven't been to an introductory MMIS training yet, please register soon. See www.oregon.gov/DHS/mmis/training-info.shtml for registration information.

Changes to the DHS Remittance Advice

The DHS remittance advice (RA) for currently enrolled Primary Care Managers (PCMs) contains detailed information for both claims you submitted and the per-member-per-month premium payment (\$6.00) by client. You currently receive this RA either on paper or electronically.

In the replacement MMIS, the RA will contain claims detail information only. Information about the per-member-per-month premium payment will be on the claims detail level (*e.g.*, 10 members times \$6.00 will appear as a single \$60.00 capitation payment), not on a client level. To balance your direct deposit or check payment, use the total amount in the RA.

How to receive client-level detail related to PCM claims

Client detail information about the per-member-per-month premium payment and enrollment/eligibility information will appear in the following Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) transactions. You will need the ability to receive and process these EDI transactions to obtain detail information in the replacement system:

- **PCM Premium Capitation Payments (820):** The 820 transaction is created weekly and monthly depending on the addition or termination of enrollees. The 820 will contain client-specific information for the \$6.00 per-member-per-month premium payments.

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- **PCM Enrollment Information (834):** The “834 transaction” is created on a daily and monthly basis. The daily 834 transaction happens only when there is enrollment or disenrollment activity. The monthly transaction is a snapshot in time of all current enrollees. The 834 will contain client-specific information about which clients were enrolled as PCM members and their pertinent eligibility information.

During the transition from the current PCM remittance advice to the 820 and 834 EDI transactions, DHS will provide client-level information upon request (contact information below).
