## **Evidence Based Practices: Adoption & Implementation Workgroup Minutes**

### **Selection and Validation Workgroup Discussion:**

Bob Miller presented an update of the Selection and Validation Workgroup. The OMHAS staff list of EBPs provisionally approved is in the survey sent to the counties. The county survey directions, list of EBPs and brief explanations of some of them were distributed and are attached. Bob clarified that this **list is provisional and not complete**, it is the work done to this date. OMHAS staff will continue to work on reviewing EBPs.

Jon Collins plans to have the external review committee established by June. He plans to have the system prepared to start accepting applications for review by July. As practices are approved they will be added to the list and posted on the website.

### **Action:**

The results of the EBP survey will be posted on the website. The results will be included in the OMHAS Ways and Means Testimony in March.

### **State Hospital Plan Discussion:**

The workgroup reviewed the plan and provided the following feedback;

- The plan should include a task/objective column.
- There was concern that consumers/families have input into the plan and they suggested that feedback would be helpful. It was suggested that consumers who have been recently discharged be interviewed.
- There was concern that each unit had a different plan, the workgroup suggested that one area of general concern be addressed hospital wide. *Examples included integrated treatment for co-occurring disorders, use of ASAM and medication formulas.*
- There was concern that there did not appear to be much substance abuse treatment, yet they understand that about 80% of those in the hospital have co-occurring disorders.

Action:

- Plan to be reviewed by OMHAS EBP Steering Committee
- Bob Miller will meet with Ted Ficken and share the feedback
- Plan to be updated and presented to A and I workgroup.

**CHMP Rule Revision Discussion:**

- Bob Miller distributed the work plan for the CMHP rule revision. OMHAS staff will draft language this spring.
- A stakeholder's workgroup will work on the rule changes. The goal is to have the new rule in place by Jan. 06.
- Bob invited members to contact Mike Morris if they wanted to serve on the workgroup or had other names.
- Ann Uhler expressed interest in reviewing the drafts as she has experience and is serving on the Governor's Council.

**New Co-Occurring Rule Discussion:**

- C.J Reid, lead on the rule development, announced that the first OMHAS staff meeting is on March 14<sup>th</sup>.
- There will be a stakeholder's workgroup following initial staff work.
- Those interested were encouraged to contact C.J. Reid.
- The goal is to have the public hearings in late summer.

Action:

- C.J. will make an EBP work plan for this rule change.
- The draft rule will be distributed to the A & I workgroup for review.

**New Corrections Rule Discussion:**

- C. J. Reid is the lead on the development of this rule. The rule will cover three levels of care, institutional programs, community programs and Oregon Youth Authority programs.
- Internal discussion has begun. Stakeholders will be notified as this process moves.

Action:

- C.J. will make an EBP work plan for this rule change.
- Notice of the stakeholder meeting will be sent to the A & I workgroup.

### **Prevention Rule Discussion:**

- Karen Wheeler's unit will not do site reviews this year and instead will work to write a Prevention Rule.
- Participants who are interested that workgroup can let Karen know.

### **Action:**

- Karen will make a work plan for this rule change.
- Work plan will be shared with A & I workgroup.

### **Communications Plan Discussion:**

- Shawn Clark distributed the communication plan
  - The group thought it was through but wants the website to be easy to access.
  - Summary reports monthly in addition to the meeting minutes posted.
