Fidelity Project	<p>This year, AMH is conducting the fidelity project for two purposes, to meet the peer review requirement for the Substance Abuse Block Grant and to gather information on how to institutionalize agency practices to support adherence to the EBPS. The AMH project is reviewing 8 programs for five practices.
