We wanted to have future rates reflect use of EBPs. Bob Nikkel and Bruce Goldberg, decided to pilot two practices (ACT)) and SE as fee for service for these practices to gather information for the actuaries. The program will start January 1, 2008. Providers will apply and be approved. Approved providers will use ACT and SE procedure codes. AMH/DMAP will collect the cost data. Programs can implement these practices as there are many other procedure codes to use to get reimbursed for the specific services. (Inventory) Jon’s staff is currently reviewing the list for correctness, completeness and will identify gaps in the provision of care.</p> <p>Stakeholders discussed survey methods and options to collect data to indicate to AMH and the legislature the numbers of EBPs being implemented and the cost effectiveness. This practice is on the NREPP list and specific for adult MH group and residential homes, it is inexpensive. • Collaborative Problem Solving. (CPS) An adolescent MH practice. <p>AMH has recently approved the following practices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT). There are now 2 practices with the acronym ACT. • ASIST-which is a training program for suicide prevention <p>AMH will be following-up with peer delivered/recovery services.
