State construction projects hold Junction City community meeting

What: State of Oregon-hosted Junction City community meeting

Details: The new Junction City psychiatric hospital, which will open in 2013, will be co-located with the Department of Corrections' (DOC) new minimum-security and medium-security facilities. The Department of Human Services (DHS) and DOC are working collaboratively on the Junction City facilities to ensure that the agencies maximize all appropriate opportunities for shared efficiencies.

This meeting is an opportunity for members of the greater Junction City community to receive information and provide input regarding these two construction projects. Leaders from DOC and DHS will be available to answer questions and address concerns.
