**September 23:**

- *System start date for enrolling providers.* Contracted enrolling providers can use the system for client enrollment, data collection, and claims submission for all new clients.
- Web training modules available online.
- Classroom training: 8:30am-12pm, Portland State Office Building, Portland, OR

**September 30:**

- Classroom training: 8:30am-12pm, Josephine County Health Department, Grants Pass, OR

**October 1:**

- Classroom training: 1-4:30pm, Portland State Office Building Portland, OR

**October 7:**

- Classroom training: 1-4:30pm, St. Charles Medical Center, Bend, OR

**October 27:**

- **DEADLINE:** Paper enrollment forms, tracking forms, and claims will not be accepted at the BCCP administrative office for clients enrolled after this date. These clients must be enrolled via the BCCP Web Data System.

**November 3:**

- System start date for ancillary providers.

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**Claims Submission**

*\*Note about Classroom training (for enrolling providers only):*

- A prerequisite for attending classroom training is to have an assigned user name and password for logging in to the system. The login request form is available at [www.healthoregon.org/bcc](http://www.healthoregon.org/bcc). Click on "What providers need to know," then "Request a Web Data System User Name & Password."
- To enroll in a classroom training session send an email to [bccp.info@state.or.us](mailto:bccp.info@state.or.us). Session size is limited, so enroll early.

**October 27:**

- All Enrolling Providers are required to enroll all new clients using the system.

**November 3:**

- Web Training for ancillary providers are available online. Use Web Training to become familiar with the new data collector and billing processes.
- Ancillary providers begin submitting claims using the Web Data System for all new clients.

**November 24:**

- DEADLINE: Paper-based claims submitted on or after this date will be returned, unless they relate to clients enrolled before the new system implementation.

- You can input claims directly into the BCCP Web Data System or to submit them electronically using the HIPAA standard 837 format.
- The system can accept claims electronically using the 837 Professional format (837P) but not the 837 Institutional form (837I).

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## BCCP Web Data System

- If you plan to bill using the 837P and would like to receive specifications, or if you need to bill using the 837I, please email [bccp.info@state.or.us](mailto:bccp.info@state.or.us).
- An internet-based program that allows enrolling providers (primary care providers), ancillary providers (labs, hospitals, surgeons, imaging facilities), and state administrators to collect and share information.
- Allows data and claims be submitted to BCCP electronically, eliminating the need for paper forms and manual processing data and claims.
- Enrolling providers will submit data and claims. Ancillary providers will submit claims only.
