Women - Under 40	☐	Eligible for breast services when symptoms are clinically documented (see list of symptoms)	Eligible
Women - 40-49	☐	Eligible if client is reporting symptoms	Eligible
Women - 50-64	☐	Eligible	Eligible
Women - 65+	☐	Eligible, but should strongly recommend enrollment in MediCare for more comprehensive services	Not eligible
Men - any age	☐	Eligible for breast services when symptoms are clinically documented (see list of symptoms)	Not eligible

U.S. Citizen or Qualified Alien	☐	Eligible (self reported)	Required for eligibility *
Oregon Resident	☐	Eligible (self reported living in Oregon or intention to live in Oregon)	Required for eligibility
Social Security #	☐	Not required	Required for eligibility *

Income	☐	Eligible (self reported - under 250% Federal Poverty Level Income Guidelines)	Presumed eligible when diagnosed through BCCP
Insurance			
Uninsured	☐	Eligible (self reported)	Eligible
Insured	☐	Eligible if insurance has deductible of \$500 or more, and/or insurance does not cover preventive exams	Not eligible
