**New Mammography Payment Policy** – Beginning in 2009, the Oregon Breast and Cervical Cancer Program (BCCP) will pay for one screening mammogram per individual client in a two year period of time. To find out more about this policy, go to:

**2009 Federal Poverty Level** – Federal Poverty Levels are revised and released yearly in the Federal Registry. BCCP implements these new rates at the beginning of the grant year (July 1).

### Training

- **Clinical Breast Exam Training.** The goal of the clinical breast exam training is to teach a standardized and comprehensive technique called the Vertical Strip Three Pressure Method, or VS3PM. The Oregon Health Sciences University Breast Health Education Program (BHEP) has been training health care professionals in Oregon to do clinical breast exams using VS3PM with support from BCCP since 1999. BCCP offers 75% scholarships to BCCP rural providers.
