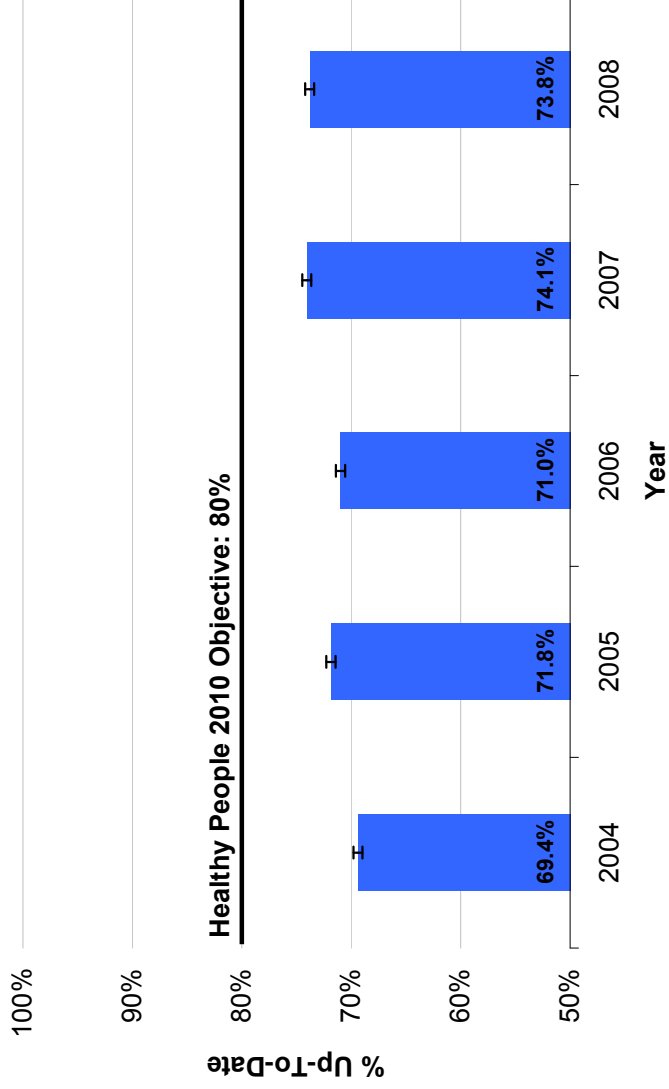


## 4:3:1:3:3:1 Immunization Rate by Year Oregon Two Year Olds, 2004-2008

Notes: (1) Up-To-Date (UTD) rate is the percent of two year olds who completed all doses in the corresponding series.

Valid doses meet ACIP recommended early childhood immunization spacing and age requirements for all years except 2004 and 2005.

(2) Two year olds are defined as children 24 to 35 months of age.

(3) The 4:3:1:3:3:1 series includes four doses of DTaP, three doses of IPV, one dose of MMR, three doses of Hib (or the two dose Merck series), three doses of HepB, and one dose of Varicella vaccine.
