RULE SUMMARY

The Department of Human Services, Public Health Division is temporarily amending rules to suspend the *Haemophilus influenzae* type B (Hib) immunization requirement for children in childcare, preschool, and Head Start facilities. Exclusion orders for Hib will not be issued during February 2009. These rule changes are needed because of a Hib vaccine shortage. In addition to amending the rule text, the "Primary Review Table" referenced in OAR 333-050-0120 is being temporarily amended to reflect the suspension.
