Nutramigen Powder – old or new?

The search for Nutramigen Powder

All infants on the old 16 oz. Nutramigen Lipil Powder were converted to 12.6 oz. Nutramigen Lipil with Enflora Powder because the old 16 oz. cans of Nutramigen Lipil will not be available after December, 2009.

- The new Nutramigen Enflora can size is smaller, so the client can receive more cans. The two types of Nutramigen powder are not interchangeable on the vouchers or at the store.
- Some participants are having difficulty finding the new 12.6 oz Nutramigen Enflora powder.
- We are making the 16 oz. Nutramigen Lipil Powder available in Fresh Choices for the next few months until supplies of the 12.6 oz. Nutramigen Enflora powder are more available. Modules of 16 oz. Nutramigen Lipil powder available on the search screen will be:
 - NUT-LP-P-01
 - NUT-LP-P-02
 - NUT-LP-P-03
 - NUT-LP-P-04
 - NUT-LP-P-05
 - NUT-LP-P-06
 - NUT-LP-P-07
 - NUT-LP-P-08
- Amounts of 16 oz. Nutramigen Lipil powder available by category:
 - Special child – 1 to 8 cans
 - IB 1-3 – 1 to 3 cans
 - IB 4-6 – 1 to 4 cans
 - IB 7-12 – 1 to 3 cans
 - IBN 1-3 – 4 to 7 cans
 - IBN 4-6 – 5 to 7 cans
 - IBN 7-12 – 4 to 5 cans
 - IN 1-3 – 7 cans
 - IN 4-6 – 8 cans
 - IN 7-12 – 6 cans

- If 12.6 oz. Nutramigen Enflora powder is available in your area, it is best to keep participants on that formula and give them information about where to find it, rather than switch them to 16 oz. Nutramigen Lipil powder that will soon not be available. Another option would be to offer concentrate or ready-to-feed for a month until supplies of 12.6 oz. Nutramigen Enflora powder are available.
- There are 2 Nutramigen formulas listed on the *Food Module Search* screen.
 - For 12.6 oz. Nutramigen powder look for "Nutramigen Enflora LGG".
 - For Nutramigen concentrate, ready-to-feed, and 16 oz. powder look for "Nutramigen Lipil".
- Medical documentation entered for 16 oz. Nutramigen Lipil powder converted over to 12.6 oz. Nutramigen Enflora powder. If you are switching which Nutramigen powder you are providing, you may need to re-enter the medical documentation information in TWIST.

Issues and Solutions

Providing 2 different formulas to children

The steps to providing 2 different formulas to children are as follows:

1. Calculate the amount of each formula that will not go over the max and find the correct formula modules.
2. On the *Food Package Assignment* row for this month assign the first formula module in Module C and save.
3. Go to the *Family Summary Screen* and print.
4. Add another row for this month and assign the second formula module in Module C and save.
5. Go to the *Family Summary Screen* and print.

Providing medical formulas to infants that will be children next month

The steps to providing medical formulas to infants who turn 1 year old this month are as follows:

1. Print current month's vouchers if not printed.
2. Change the infant category to IN if currently another category. (Infants can get medical formulas without being marked special. Only 7-12 month old non-breastfeeding infants can be marked special since they are the ones that might need the extra amount of formula rather than baby food.)
3. Mark the "Special" check box on the *Food Package Assignment* screen. This activates Module C in future rows
4. Assign the medical formula module in Module C and save.
5. Go to the *Family Summary Screen* and print future months.
