New information

Dating Medical Documentation

There is a bug in the *Medical Documentation* screen that requires you to put in a start date for the med doc which matches the start date of the module requiring medical documentation in order to get your “Y” in the *Med Doc Status* field. This bug will be fixed in an upcoming release.

- Until the bug is fixed, enter a start date for the medical documentation that matches the start date of the module. For example, if the med doc is dated 8/5 but the module starts 8/1, enter 8/1 as the med doc start date.
- The correct med doc start date can be documented in the notes field if there are any concerns.

Soy beverage modules

Soy beverage modules will always have an even number of quarts because one of the WIC approved brands comes in a half gallon carton. This means that some packages will have one quart less than the liquid cow’s milk equivalent.

- Example: The soy beverage equivalent of the child’s milk module 101-13 is 501-12. (This is listed incorrectly on the job aid.)
- If a participant wants the full amount of soy beverage, they can select the package with no cheese, e.g. 500-16.

Clarifications

Changing to “Some breastfeeding” from “Mostly Breastfeeding”

The steps to make this change are as follows:

1. Check the WBN or IBN check box on the *Food Package Assignment* screen.
2. Select the new food package (from the drop down or use the search screen).
3. Forecast the module or select the appropriate modules for the remaining months of the certification.
4. Save.
5. Go to the *Family Summary Screen* and print.
6. If unable to print due to a mismatch (M shows in the FI field), fast path to the other half of the dyad’s cert record and make the corresponding changes and save.

Finding Nutramigen Powder in TWIST

All infants on the old 16 oz. Nutramigen Powder were converted to 12.6 oz. Nutramigen Lipil with Enflora Powder. The can size is smaller, so the client can receive more cans.

- There are 2 Nutramigen formulas listed on the *Food Module Search* screen. For Nutramigen powder look for "Nutramigen Lipil with Enflora".
- For Nutramigen concentrate and ready-to-feed look for “Nutramigen Lipil”.
- If you use “Nutramigen Lipil” and select “powder” as the formula type, you will find nothing.
