Medical documentation is required for issuance of these formulas. Formulary is subject to change.

- A qualifying medical condition/diagnosis must support the use of these formulas. Reasons such as 'intolerance, spitting up or doesn't like' are not qualifying medical conditions and will not be accepted as a substitute for a medical diagnosis.
- Medical documentation is valid up to but not exceeding 12 months.
