**Examples of non-qualifying conditions that do not support the issuance of special medical formulas by WIC:**

- Non-specific formula/food intolerance, spitting up, colic, or constipation.
- Food or formula intolerance that can be successfully managed with the use of one of the other WIC food packages or contract formulas.
- Solely for the purpose of enhancing nutrient intake or managing body weight without an underlying qualifying medical condition (i.e. 'picky eater', small for age, etc.)
