How can Local agencies use these Emergency cards?

These cards are perfect to hand out during special events or promotions. They can also be inserted easily into the *WIC Nutrition for you and your family* brochure (dated 6/09--- be sure you have the most current version) and given to:

- Head Start and Early Head Start programs
- Daycares and preschool centers
- Women's shelters and food pantries
- Emergency preparedness or disaster relief program staff. These can be programs within your local health department or within your community (i.e. Red Cross). Be sure to remind the staff of these programs of our target audience so this resource reaches those we serve.
