Modules

Module A - milk modules or formula modules

Module B - food modules

Module C - formula modules

Example:

Milk module = milk + cheese

Food module = eggs + cereal + juice + whole grains + peanut butter + fruits/veggies

Food package = milk module + food module

Status boxes

Med doc status = Indicates if medical documentation is needed or has been received.

Module status = Indicates if vouchers from the modules have been printed, voided, or on the print queue.

Participant flags

Special Client = Participant needs medical foods or formula or a special food pkg.

IBN/WBN = Flags participants that are doing **some** breastfeeding

Twins or more = Indicates the Twins checkbox is marked on Medical data screen

Current Assignment

Indicates the modules currently selected on the Food Package Assignment screen.

Search criteria

- Different search criteria for each type of module
- Selecting a criteria limits the results to those that match
- Formula search is an alpha search by name of the formula

Search results

- Shows all modules that are eligible for the participant category
- List is shortened as search criteria are selected
- Double clicking on a module in the results section selects it and causes it to show in the module display area.
- Once a module is selected, clicking apply will bring your selection to the FPA screen.

Module display

- Shows the distribution of the foods on the vouchers for the modules selected.

Documentation section

- Enter start and end date of the medical documentation, the health care provider's name and any notes.

Medical formulas or soy beverage

- Lists the formulas or foods from the FPA needing medical documentation
- Check the ones for which medical documentation has been received.

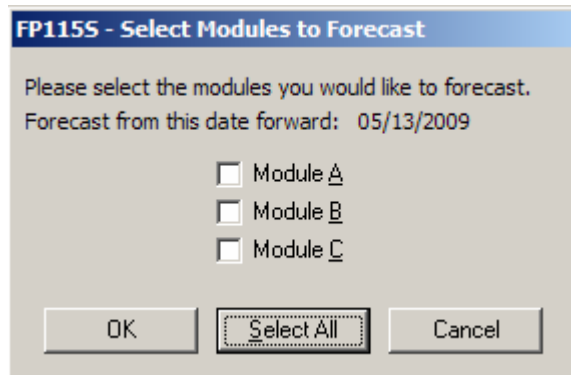
Supplemental foods

- Indicate if the health care provider wants the participant to receive no supplemental foods or the full standard food package of supplemental milk and food.
- If the 3rd box is checked you will indicate in the “**Exclusions**” box which foods the HCP does not want the participant to receive. All other milk or food could be issued.

Note: Completion of this screen changes the Med Doc Status on the FPA and allows issuance of the food package.

Forecasting modules

You can use the “Forecast” button to assign modules to future months. It’s as easy as 1 – 2 – 3 – 4!



1. Select the row you want to forecast on the FPA screen.
2. Click the “Forecast” button.
3. On the “Select Modules to Forecast” pop-up, check which module or modules you want to forecast or click the “Select all” button.
4. Click “ok”.
 - Whatever modules have been selected will be forecast into future month rows.
 - If the participant category changes, TWIST will either change the module to one they are eligible for (e.g. formula amounts for infants) or leave the row blank.

Added features

- The module code is displayed for each voucher. This makes it easier to void all the vouchers associated with a particular module.
- Formula exchange can be done on this screen using “Formula Exchange” as the void reason and then entering the number of cans returned.
- The **voucher description** at the bottom of the screen shows the foods on the voucher selected in the “Results” section of the screen.
