Increase in License Fees

House Bill 2442 was passed by the legislature and signed by the governor this summer. Included in this House Bill is a provision for an increase in licensing fees for both community based care and nursing facilities. These fees for initial and renewal licensing and for change of ownerships will take effect January 1, 2010. Therefore, the new fees will apply for facilities that are due for licensure renewal in January.

Annual fees for Nursing Facilities will be:

- 1 to 15 beds - \$180.00
- 16 to 49 beds - \$260.00
- 50 to 99 beds - \$520.00
- 100 to 150 beds \$670.00
- 151 or more beds - \$750.00.

Biennial fees for Residential Care and Assisted Living Facilities will be:

- 1 to 15 beds - \$360.00
- 16 to 49 beds - \$520.00
- 50 to 99 beds - \$1,040.00
- 100 to 150 beds - \$1,340.00
- 151 or more beds - \$1,500.00
