Increase in Licensing Fees

Clarification

An Administrator Alert went out on October 1, 2009 informing providers of the increase of licensing application fees that will take effect on January 1, 2010. These fees will also include applications for change of management as well as initial and renewal licensing and changes of ownership. New fees that go into effect starting January 1, 2010 are as follows:

Annual fees for Nursing Facilities will be:

- 1 to 15 beds - \$180.00
- 16 to 49 beds - \$260.00
- 50 to 99 beds - \$520.00
- 100 to 150 beds \$670.00
- 151 or more beds - \$750.00.

Biennial fees for Residential Care and Assisted Living Facilities will be:

- 1 to 15 beds - \$360.00
- 16 to 49 beds - \$520.00
- 50 to 99 beds - \$1,040.00
- 100 to 150 beds - \$1,340.00
- 151 or more beds - \$1,500.00
