Delay of Implementation of Summary of Emergency Plans

The requirement [OAR 411-086- 0320(6) and OAR 411-054-009(6)] for nursing and CBC facilities to submit to the state a summary of their Emergency Plans is being temporarily delayed until the fall, in order to lessen the impact upon facilities. Further information will follow in the fall about the new due date and submission instructions. For those who would like to know, the form that will be required is DHS 0938 form, obtained at http://dhsresources.hr.state.or.us/WORD_DOCS/DE0938.doc. This form will be submitted via email, with instructions provided on the form.

Plans which have been already submitted in this format will be saved and facilities will not need to resubmit unless the information has significantly changed.
