***Web Browser Addition Required by November 12, 2010,
to Access MDS 3.0 submissions and the QIES reports,
including CASPER reports.***

Dear Administrator,

Please share this Administrator Alert with facility staff that work with MDS, submissions and those that access any CASPER or QIES reports. This includes error, validation and missing assessment reports.

Action Required:

Effective November 15, 2010, the Transport Layer Security (TLS) 1.0 must be active in your web browser in order to access QIES National Systems, including the new MDS 3.0 Submission System. This change can be made at any time with no effect on your current work. Browser settings must be updated by November 12, 2010.

Follow the steps below to activate TLS 1.0:

STEP	ACTION
1	Open the Internet Explorer browser.
2	Select "Tools" from the Menu bar.
3	Click on "Internet Options".
