Learn about HIPAA 5010 implementation at the September MMIS Update

Dear Administrators,

All health care payers, including Medicaid, Medicare, and private health insurance carriers are moving to HIPAA 5010 (health care) and NCPDP D.0 (pharmacy) transactions. On and after Jan. 1, 2012, the Oregon Health Authority's Division of Medical Assistance Programs (DMAP) will only accept 5010 and NCPDP D.0 transactions.

If you bill DMAP (Oregon Medicaid) using a format other than paper claims or the Provider Web Portal at <https://www.or-medicaid.gov>, this change affects you.
