## **Survey on Smoking Cessation with Community Based Care**

The Public Health Division will be conducting a brief survey of all community-based facilities, in order to learn more about your experiences with smoking cessation resources and with helping residents quit smoking.

Many facilities are interested in ways to help residents quit smoking because quitting can improve resident and staff health, and can also reduce facility costs, since smoke-free facilities often have lower insurance premiums.

The survey will be conducted on-line. It should take about 5-10 minutes and Facility Administrators or their designees can do it whenever it is convenient.

We hope many community-based facilities will take this opportunity to share information with Public Health, and to learn more about smoking cessation resources in Oregon. Furthermore, staff from Public Health will send interested facilities free cessation resources for residents!
