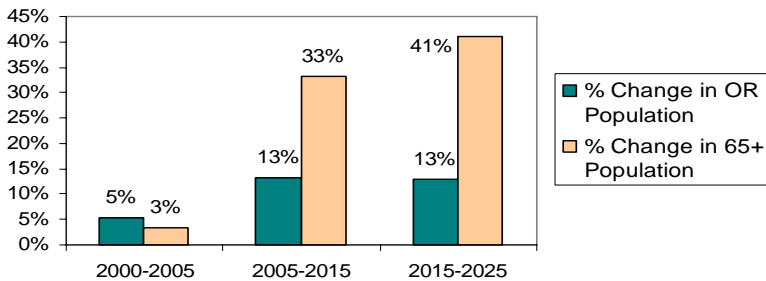

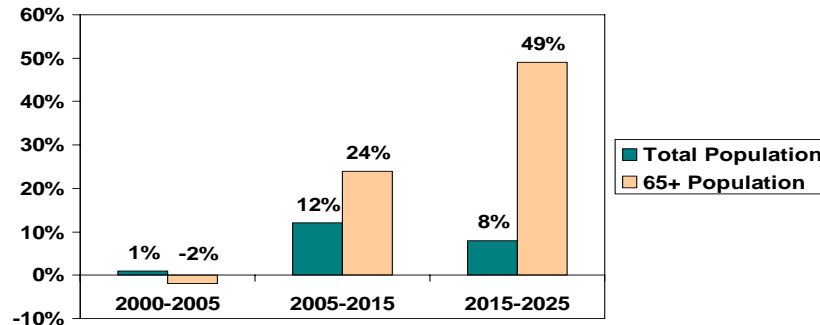

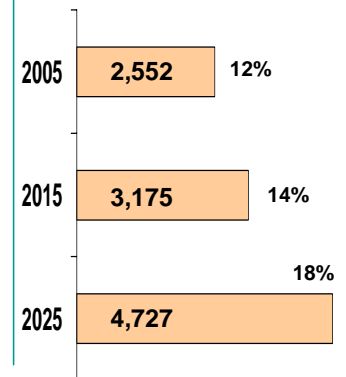
Growth Rate of Oregon's Aging Population



Growth Rate Of Hood River County's Aging Population

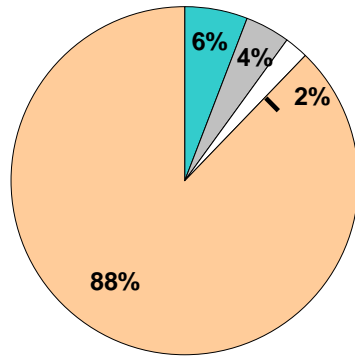


Hood River County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population

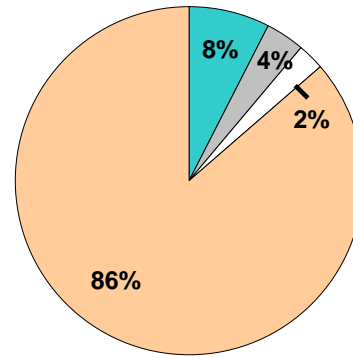

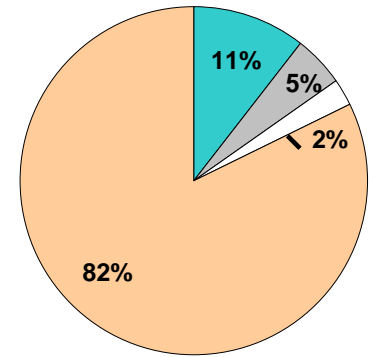

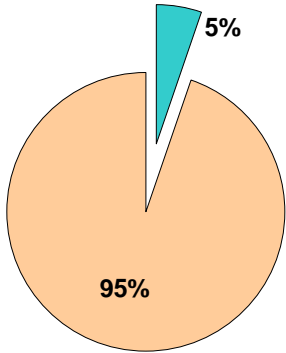

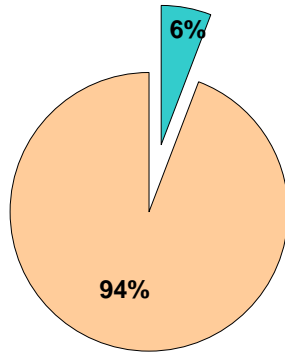

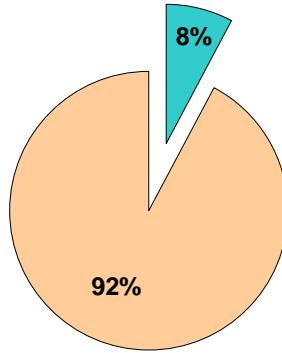

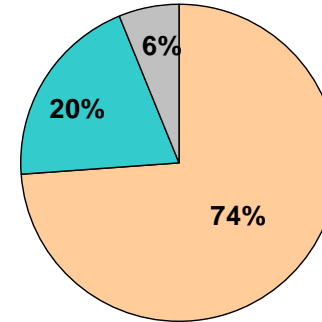

National % of Seniors Needing Assistance Due to Disability



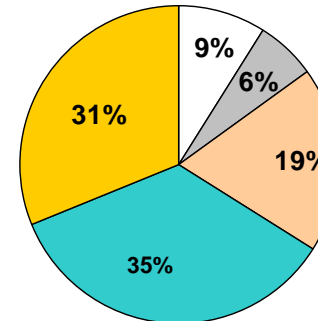

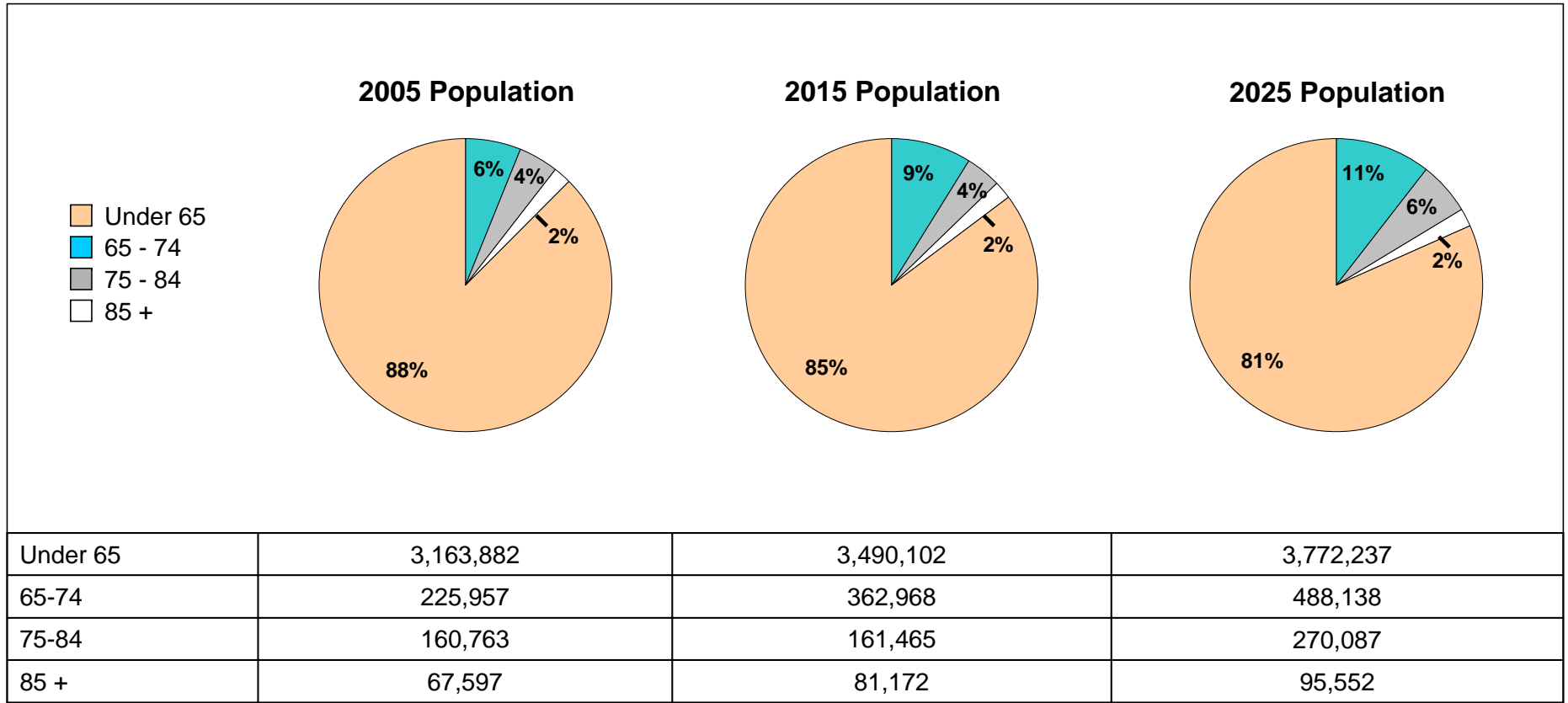
