

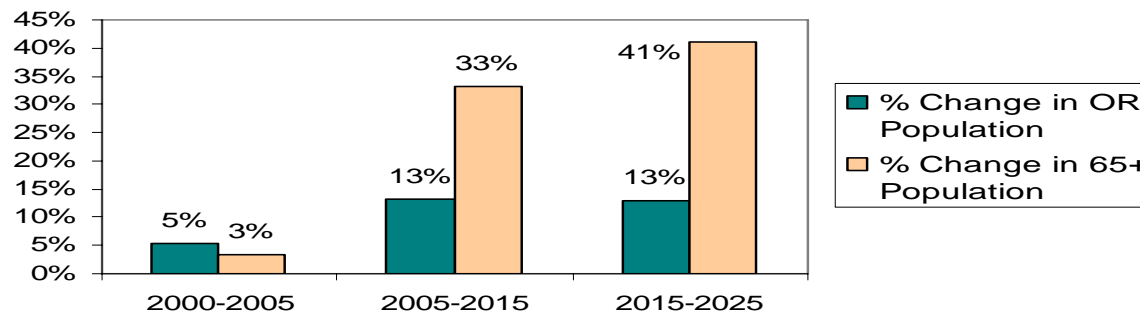

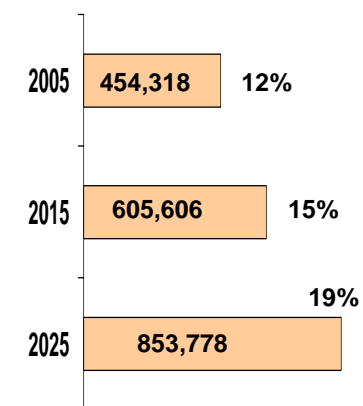

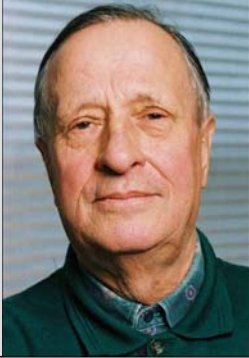


Growth Rate of Oregon's Aging Population



Projected 65+ Population and % of general population



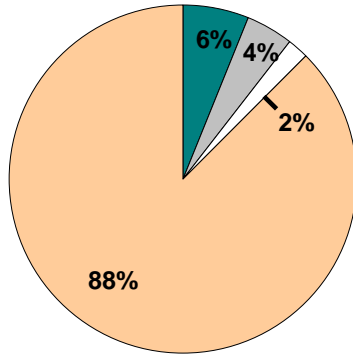

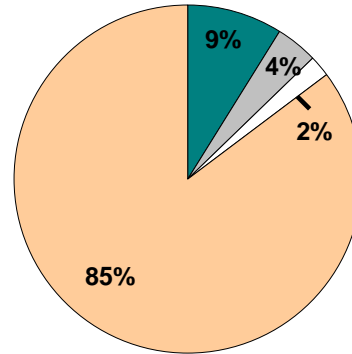

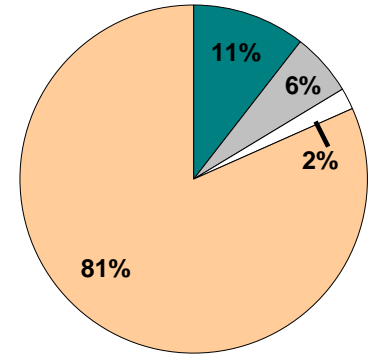

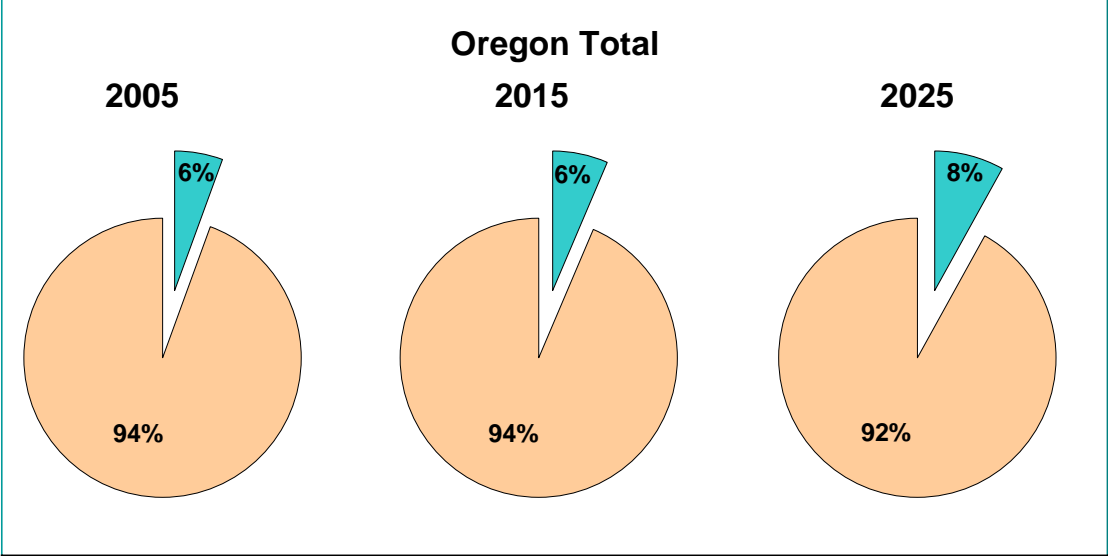
