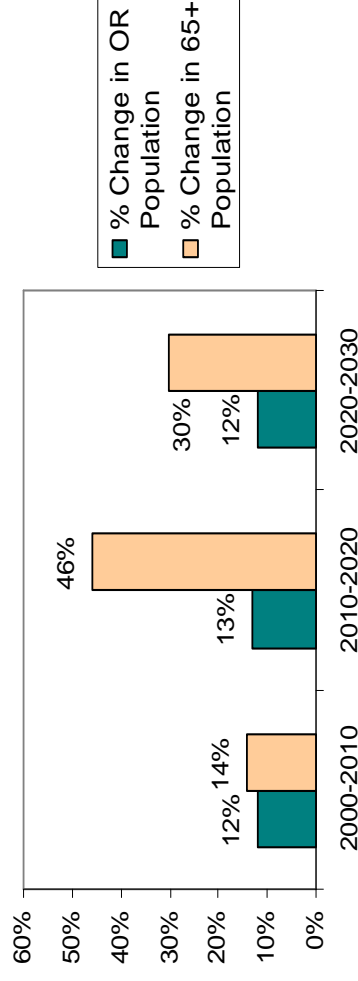

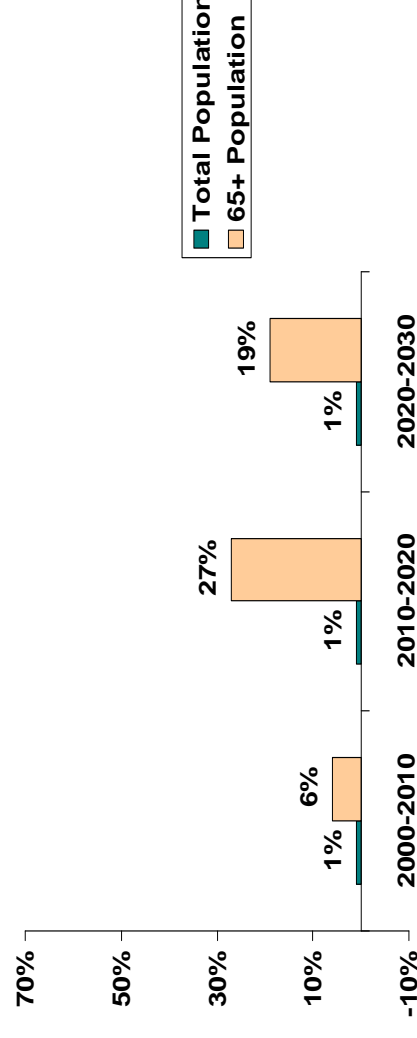

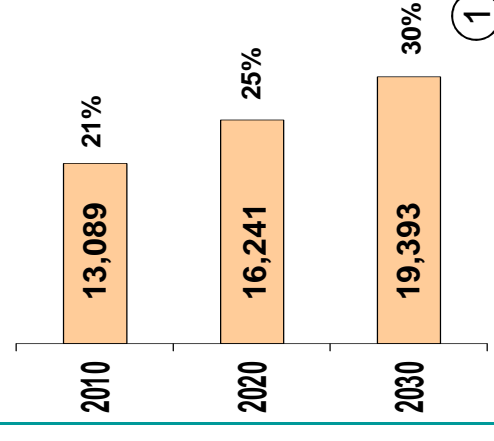
## Growth Rate of Oregon's Aging Population



## Growth Rate Of Coos County's Aging Population

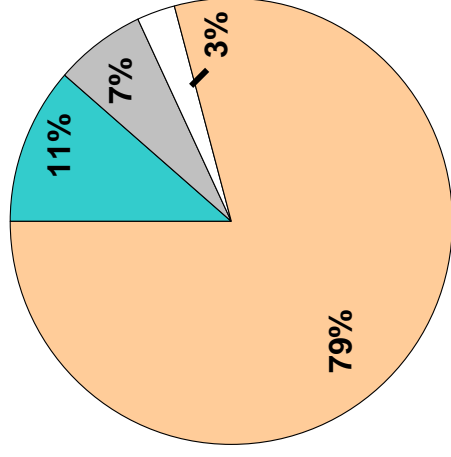


## Coos County Projected 65+ Population and % of general population

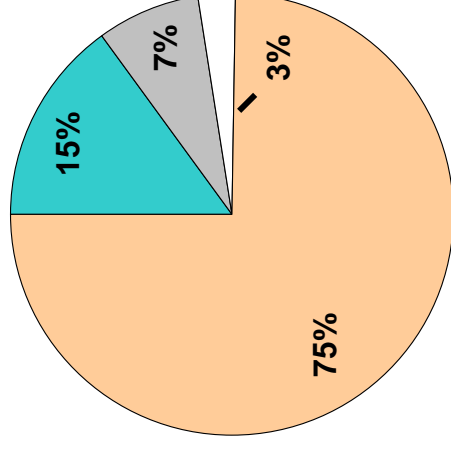

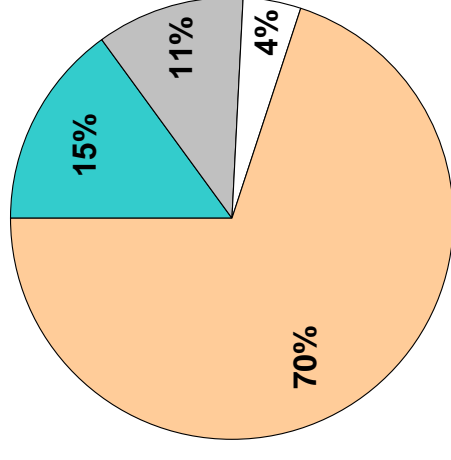

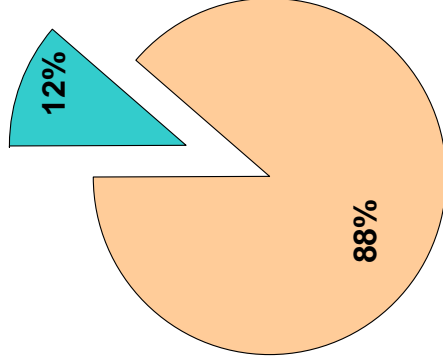

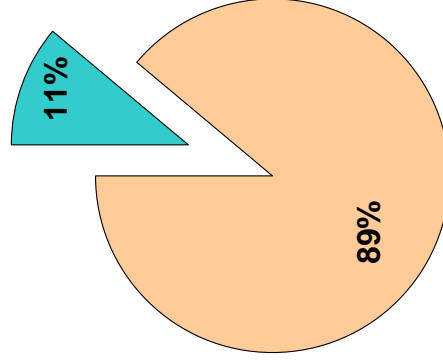

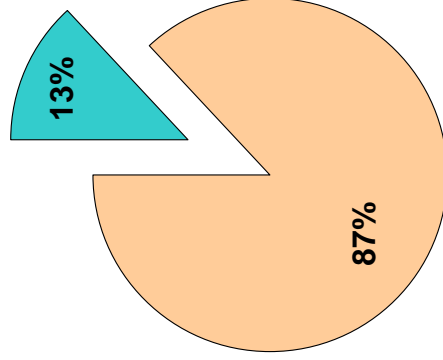

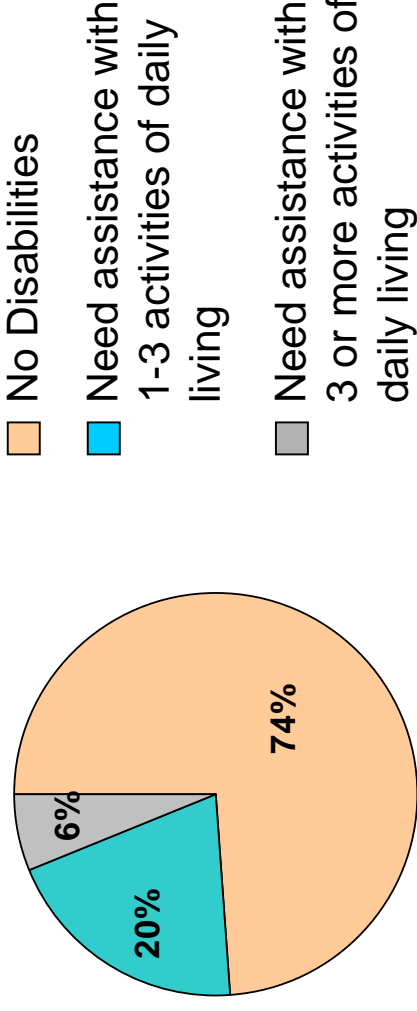

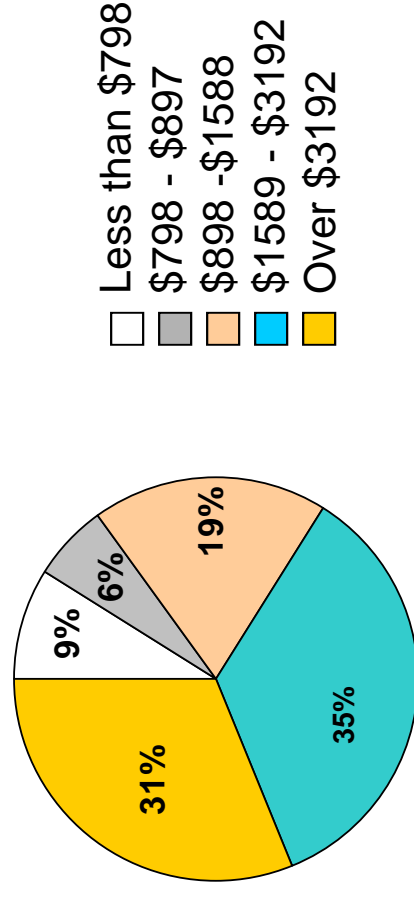

#### National % of Seniors Needing Assistance Due to Disability



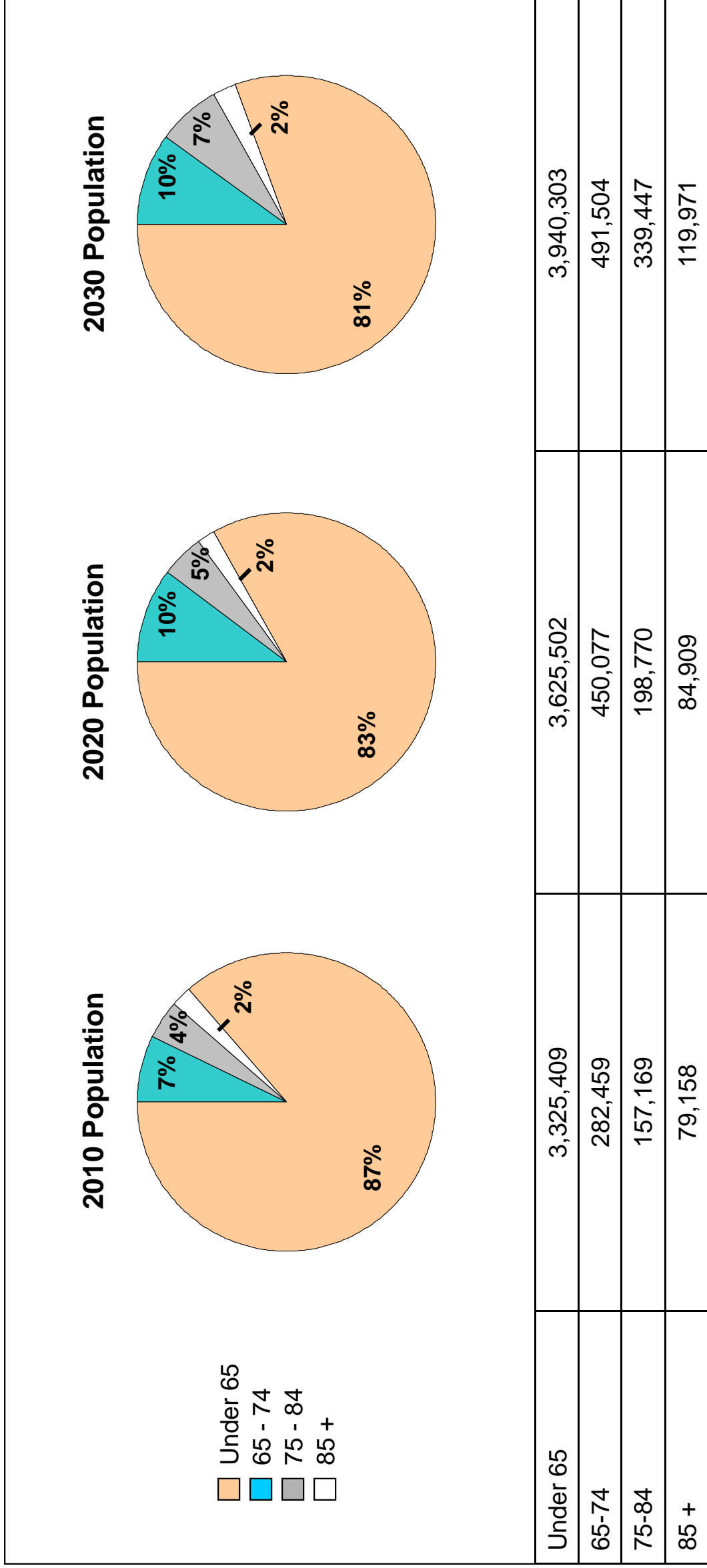
