MINUTES

INTROS AND COUNTY UPDATES:

Intros:

- Lincoln Co. Director leads off thanking PO's.
- Budgets are tough – Counties share changes due to budget cuts
- Bill Sawyer (DOC)
 - Web page: There is an SOSN link on the OACCD website; Manette Emra can make updates.
 - DOC has restructured departments under Community Corrections

- Dawn Persels (Compact)
 - Compact offenders cannot bail from an Interstate Compact hold. Shared example from OH – family is suing because offender was released from hold and committed murder.
 - Restructuring within Community Corrections/Transition Services
 - Stress studies are being done within the institutions

Best Practices:

Brenda Carney and Katie Gotch Present:

- Notification Level: Still working through the process, meetings, etc. Continued discussion about who goes on the website, whether there will be a board for designation, and how the board would be formed, as well as how offenders would be assessed/reassessed/appeal.
 - Jay Scroggin brought up the possibility of adding a member to the Parole Board to complete the Static-99Rs for new assessments and reassessments, for fiscal reasons. Also discussed was making it mandatory that all SO's be under the new level system – automatically placed and/or assessed for placement -- and the board would be the authority.
- New SO IRT – No feedback re: use.
- SO Package B: Handout for comparison/proposed changes. Brenda will send out email for greater feedback for proposed changes – eliminate or reduce package requirements, as counties are split between supervising all, some or no Pkg B cases.
- Package B: not statutorily mandated.

Parole Board Update-Jay Scroggin:

- HO training: Late August or early September; geared toward new PO's; possible live hearing.
- Release packet: Board is working on including psych/predatory evals.
- Legislative Concept: If PO's later work for the Board, they can maintain their DPSST certification.
- Board has had problems getting juvenile records, as the Board/P&P is not listed in ORS as eligible agencies for release.

Election of SOSN 3rd Chair:

Dru VanRiper was nominated. Unanimous vote elects Dru VanRiper as 3rd Chair.

Training Coordinator- Trin asked for assistance, primarily with annual specialized SO training. Danielle with Wash Co volunteered.

SOTX Services at OYA:

Tracie Hightower and Matt Sorenson:

Presenters discuss treatment for SO's. Transitional issues are addressed and it appears a 'release plan' of sorts may be in the future. Concerns with polygraphs, whether the whole test will be included (not just results).
