Goodwill is offering employment readiness classes. **Goodwill is not just for those with disabilities.** However, "If you have a disability or a special need and some job experience, Goodwill can help prepare you for a great job". Once you are released, Goodwill Personnel Services is a job specialist that can assist you in finding employment with a variety of companies in a wide range of temporary and long-term positions with *steady pay and great benefits*. There are immediate openings in, but not limited to the following fields: Clerical, retail, data entry, customer service, food services, janitorial, light industrial, and warehouse. Are you paroling to Lane County and are in need of housing? Then **sponsors** may be for you. Sponsors provides transitional services for ex-offenders who are paroling to Lane County, specifically transitional housing with group houses in the Eugene area. They also provide assistant with employment, A&D and higher (college) education. However, unlike other Transitional services, the application process for sponsors can start **12 months (1 year prior to release)**.
