Columbia River Correctional Institution

Columbia River Correctional Institution (CRCI) is a minimum-security facility located in northeast Portland. CRCI was opened in September 1990. CRCI provides a range of correctional services and programs that include alcohol and drug treatment, pre-release and transitional services, and adult education and work opportunities.

Special housing:

- 50-bed residential alcohol and drug treatment program (Turning Point)
- 50-bed dual diagnosis treatment unit (Freedom)

Number of staff: 132

South Fork Forest Camp (SFFC): CRCI operates the South Fork Forest Camp, a 200 bed minimum-security work camp for male inmates near Tillamook, Oregon. SFFC is managed jointly with the Oregon Department of Forestry. The inmates provide labor for forest management, firefighting, and parks maintenance.
