Note: Special consideration will be given applicants who have background/experience in post- traumatic stress counseling or corrections work and/or who are from under-represented geographical areas of Oregon and/or who are bilingual.

Incomplete or late applications may not be accepted.

February 28, 2008	Notification regarding acceptance for FDP training
March 31 - April 4, 2008	Training - 8:00 am to 5:00 pm all days
April 30, 2008	Notification regarding acceptance as a FDP Facilitator

DOC will pay for lodging and meals for participants traveling over 60 miles to the training. Mileage will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
