## Contacting the Program by Email?

Please be aware that on any given day the state's "fire wall" blocks nearly 1 million questionable emails. Even with such efforts still dozens of others get through. Often times the language in the subject line of these emails is vague enough where we question whether it is an e-mail from a constituent, or one sent for harmful reasons. To better serve you we are asking that if you send an e-mail to us, please put specific details in the subject line that make your email recognizable.

Examples would be "PS application Supply Request, Status of Oregon licensees, PI Question about licensure." E-mails with vague subject lines, or no subject listed may be mistaken as a harmful e-mail, and deleted without opening.
