

Oregon Administrative Rule Chapter 259, Division 60
PRIVATE SECURITY

A number of years ago, the Private Security and Investigator Policy Committee (PSIPC) recognized a need to review and update the private security rule set. A Rules Subcommittee was formed to review the current rules and work to develop new, legally defensible language which would more clearly identify the expectations and responsibilities of private security providers (PSP) as well as clarify Department processes.

The proposed re-write was reviewed by the PSIPC at its meeting on May 15, 2012 and again at a special meeting on June 8, 2012. The Committee unanimously recommended approval of the rule language to the Board on Public Safety Standards and Training (BPSST.) The BPSST reviewed the rule set and PSIPC recommendation at its meeting on July 26, 2012. The Board members unanimously voted to file the rule language as a proposed rule with the Secretary of State's office.

A majority of the proposed changes are simply organizational, as the current practices have not changed. However, this proposed re-write does implement a number of substantial changes, including a new definition for **alarm monitors and alarm monitoring facilities**, new **moral fitness standards** for PSPs and a **new minimum education requirement**. A new rule was also developed to clarify the requirements for **crowd management, event and guest services**.
