Subject: Land Board Action on NE Oregon Land Parcel Disposal

Recently we notified you that the Department is evaluating a number of its Common School Fund land parcels for disposal in Baker, Union, Umatilla and Wallowa Counties. Though a final decision has not been reached for each parcel, the Department has proceeded far enough along with its evaluation to request that the Land Board allow the DSL to continue to prepare these parcels for disposal. The Land Board's approval of the Department's request does not guarantee that a particular parcel will be sold or exchanged immediately; that decision as well as the timing of any disposal will depend on the results of further evaluation including consultation with key commenters, particularly other state natural resource agencies.

The Land Board will act on the Department's request at its June 12 meeting in Salem.

We appreciate the comments made by many of you concerning these parcels and expect to continue to work with you as the process continues.
