Mr. Lilly,

I received a heads up that you are considering selling hunting rights to outfitters and guides and excluding the rest of us from this portion of OUR land. I use that area frequently and am against any limitation or restriction on our historical free access to this tract of land.

I have seen one of your responses which looked to me like a canned reply and said nothing about the reasoning or projections that support this plan. I'm interested in where this plan originated and who in particular is supporting it. We'd all appreciate some economic info on it. How much do you think this will generate? Where will that money come from? Are there current proposals from outfitters to close this area? Why have you singled out this particular tract of state land?

Rather than exclude everybody, why not sell an annual state lands access permit for \$10 per person for any and all use of all state lands and dedicate it to the schools. (I do understand that not all state land is in this program.) This would include hikers, hunters, birdwatchers, both resident and non-residents.
