

Fee Increases Effective January 1, 2009

Two laws that passed during the 2007 legislative session – HB 2105 and HB 2106 -- direct DSL to revise removal-fill and delineation review fees annually, effective January 1st of each year based on the change in the Portland-Salem, OR-WA Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all Urban Consumers for all items published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor. It does not affect the general authorization fees for certain projects, which remain at \$250.

The CPI has risen by 3.9% over the last reportable period. DSL has applied the increase to the application base and volume fees as well as the delineation review fee and rounded the new fees to the nearest dollar. The new fees are listed below.

To determine the fee for your removal-fill permit, take the fee for the volume of removal and/or fill and add it to the base fee listed at left below for the appropriate applicant category (private, public, or commercial operator). If the project involves both removal and fill, pay the fee associated with fill activities.
