


## Create Otter Exclusion Rule in Kaspersky


Before installing Otter open Kaspersky. Click “Settings” in the bottom left of the Kaspersky window.




Select “Additional” from the options on the left




Select “Threats and Exclusions” from the options on the right.



Select “Configure exclusion rules”



Click "Add" in the lower right hand corner
