ACTIONS TAKEN, MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES, AND OTHER MILESTONES

- Letter requesting budget limitation increase for Stimulus amounts received submitted to Co-Chairs of the Joint Ways & Means committee. Awaiting approval in Senate of HB 5052 (3rd reading held June 1) – signed by Governor June 17.
- Joint letter requesting budget limitation for Stimulus amounts related to Child Care submitted to Co-Chairs of Joint Ways & Means committee (Employment/Human Services Departments both signed).
- Competitive federal grant (not ARRA) – all Legislative approvals received. Awaiting award notification from DOL.

- Competitive federal grant through ARRA in preparation for submission to Public Utility commission, to obtain funding to upgrade Business & Employment Services field office broadband capabilities. Though the formal grant opportunity will not be announced until June 30, PUC is coordinating requests from around the state.

UPCOMING PLANNED ACTIONS, MAJOR PROJECTS, DEADLINES, AND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

- Under the federal Trade Act which was reauthorized and expanded by the Stimulus legislation, Oregon firms have now filed a total of 43 petitions (out of 1,298 over all states). No determinations have been announced yet by DOL.
- HB 2203 has now been signed into law by the Governor. It authorizes minor legislative changes needed to allow Oregon to receive the remaining 2/3 of the \$90 Million stimulus money for Oregon's modernization of its unemployment system. Region 6 DOL/Employment & Training Administration is reviewing our application packet before we submit to the National Office.
- ARRA job listings for summer youth programs are posted, as are some new transportation/construction job listings.
