**ACTIONS TAKEN, MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES, AND OTHER MILESTONES**

- Under the federal Trade Act which was reauthorized and expanded by the Stimulus legislation, two Oregon firms have now been certified so their workers can receive training and allowance benefits – Tarkio and Tektronix – both in Beaverton. Tarkio (doing business as Proco Manufacturing) supplied machined parts to Credence for semiconductor manufacturing. Tektronix, a manufacturer of test and measurement equipment used by the electronics industry, shifted their call center operations to India.

- Our application for the remaining 2/3 in UI Modernization incentive funding was submitted to DOL on June 23. We are seeking approval for these funds under the following provisions: (a) an individual is not disqualified from unemployment compensation for separations due to certain compelling family reasons, and (b) an additional 26 weeks of unemployment compensation is paid to exhaustees who are enrolled in and making satisfactory progress in certain training programs. Some minor updates to ORS were needed to qualify – these were passed in HB 2203.
- Region 10 (Deschutes, Jefferson, and Crook counties) is working with the local Forest Service contracting officer so when contracts are awarded we are notified regarding job listings. Also doing outreach for local stimulus funded activities: Prineville Railway Improvement Project to be bid, Vulcan Power woody biomass project.

#### **UPCOMING PLANNED ACTIONS, MAJOR PROJECTS, DEADLINES, AND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES**

- Competitive federal grant through ARRA to obtain funding to upgrade Business & Employment Services field office broadband capabilities. The notice of funds availability was just announced on July 1. We have provided our information to the Oregon PUC for coordination and ranking. Our initial estimate is for \$483K in funding to upgrade capabilities at field offices.
- DOL has provided general information on the upcoming availability of competitive grants for green jobs. Some categories include labor market information, job training, and capacity building, all of which provide exciting opportunities to increase our value to job seekers.
